

1. To overcome the network issues in rural areas college started a **g suite account** so that students can access the recorded version of online classes.




2. Arabic and Malayalam departments organized national and international webinars.

5. One of the faculty of the Mathematics Department, Dr.Vinodkumar.P brought the students from all over India under one umbrella for preparing for JAM, GATE, JRF, etc. through the "Maths aspirants WhatsApp group".

Maths Aspirants is an initiative started by Dr Vinod Kumar P., Associate Professor of Mathematics, T.M.Govt. College, Tirur, Kerala in 2017. Maths Aspirants WhatsApp Groups were started in 2017, with limited participants from his student's circles, to provide an online platform to share and discuss views and doubts about Maths concepts and problems and to facilitate preparations for exams like JAM/NET/JRF/GATE/TIFR, etc. This students'-oriented group garnered huge acceptance soon leading to the creation of five more annexure WhatsApp groups with capacities at the maximum. These groups now emerged as an effective platform for those who are curious and passionate about Mathematics. Several of the group members succeeded in various competitive exams and now pursuing PG/Ph.D. programs in many premier institutions.

When the COVID pandemic paused regular education, Dr. Vinod started conducting Online Exam Series and Online Problem-Solving Sessions for Maths students to keep them in touch with the subject and to upkeep their practice for the competitive examinations in a timebound format.

These tests and problem-solving sessions are purely voluntary and have reportedly helped students to revise the concepts. More than 50 online examinations and more than 80 live problem-solving sessions have been successfully conducted since April 2020. The uniqueness of these Problem-Solving Sessions series is that they were handled by research scholars and young faculty members from premier institutions in India and abroad.

DURING the lockdown when the Netflix generation is falling bead over heels over the 'Pro-fessor' of smash-hit series 'Money Heist', a real-life profes Money Heist, a rear die proces-sor from Parappanangadi in Malappuram has grabbed na-tional attention for academic reasons. While educators are feeling

stuck at home due to the lock down, Dr Vinod Kumar P. assisdown, Dr Vinod Kumar P, asis-tant professor at Thunchan Me-morial College, Tirur, dilgently launched a weekly online maths test using 'Google Docs' app. By the end of his fourth test, his initiative gained ground among maths geeks across the nation, aspiring to crack competitive exams like

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NET, GATE and HT-JAM. The Net's over a student's taking up his weekly test skyrocheted as the link was shared in various study circles on social media. His fourth test, held last Sat-urday, had 933 takers from

"The response is surpris-ing," says Vinod who delved into the online medium only to conduct an internal exam for his students. His test — comprising 25 questions -- designed in multiple select for-mats, covers one topic every week. Each test is online only for 75 minutes on Saturday,



from 8pm to 9.15pm. The topic for the next ex a week before.

The earlier exams focused on topics like real analyses, topol-ogy, differential calculas, and convergence and continuity. Soon, Vinod's tests became a talking point in academic cir-

"It is seamless and impres-sive," says Avishek Adhikari, mathematics professor of the mathematics protessor of the prestigious Presidency Univer-sity, Kolkata. "By the fourth edition of the test, my students have shown remarkable im-provement in performance," he says.
