Thunchan Memorial Government College started functioning as a junior college with Pre-Degree courses in the year 1980. From there the college rose to a government college in Malabar with a B++ NAAC accreditation grade in 2016. The College now holds a unique position of pride in the education history of the district of Malappuram and is known for providing quality education in pure sciences, social sciences, and languages for both PG and UG programmes. The PG Dept. of Arabic was declared as a Research Centre in March 2018. At present, the college offers 5 UG programmes and 4 PG programmes and PG Integrated Programme in English and Media Studies. The College has 41 permanent, 2 temporary faculty members and 16 office staff. Number of students enrolled in the year is 866.
