
OBSERVANCE OF DAYS OF NATIONAL/INTERNATIONAL IMPORTANCE & FESTIVAL CELEBRATIONS




Photography Contest

Essay writing competition as part of Environment day was organized on the topic "Education and Covid-19".




World Food and Safety Day (07/06/2021

The volunteers prepared a posture on World Food and Safety day and shared the posture through whats app and other social media




World Blood Donor Day – (14/06/2021)











Reading Day 19/06/2021


International Yoga Day (21/06/2021)








Hiroshima and Nagasaki day (08-08-2021)

International Day for Older People (01-10-2021)






NSS volunteers gathered together to clean up the college and surroundings.
