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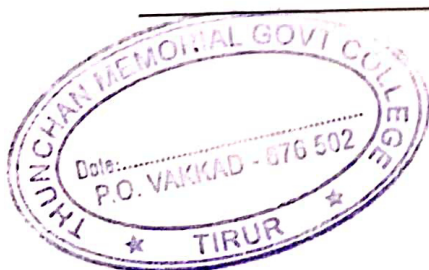
Strategic Planning and Deployment Document (SPDD)

The Thunchan Memorial Govt. College has institutional strategic plan to accomplish the vision and mission of the college. The Strategic planning and deployment document (SPDD) of the college is framed based on the SWOC analysis of the college. After analysing the internal and external environment, the institutional goals were set up in all possible growth domains through continuous thought process and discussion with all stakeholders. The strategies with action plans were decided to achieve institutional strategic goals.

Institutional Strength

- Thunchan Memorial Govt. College is one of the first higher education institution in the Tirur Taluk.
- As it is a government college, it has the benefit of getting all the government initiated projects and schemes. In addition, the College Council has full authority to take timely decisions on any academic & administrative matters.
- Merit is the sole criteria for appointment of staff and selection of students.
- Availability of all basic amenities like water, transport, etc.
- Majority of student community are female. They are comparatively more serious in their studies, and help maintain well disciplined campus culture.
- More faculty members with PhD.
- Five undergraduate programmes and four postgraduate programmes
- One Research Department with 6 research supervisors and 19 research scholars.
- The college is catering to the needs of diverse sections of the society and the inclusive education is evidenced by larger enrollment of girls and OBC students
- The college is having alumni organizations which support many of the academic and infrastructural needs of the institution.
- Excellent community-neighborhood relations
- Transparent admission procedures purely based on merit and social justice, using digital platforms
- Divyang Friendly campus with wide range of services for students with special needs
- Dynamic student community with high potential for self- empowerment
- Highly committed and responsible Parent Teacher Association

Institutional Weakness

- College is located in a coastal area and facing some issues related locality.
- Poor opportunity to consultancy and linkage programmes. The area of the college doesn't have large scale industries. Hence students have to travel to distant areas for getting practical exposure.
- Absence of academic autonomy limits the freedom to design new courses
- Tight academic schedule restricts time devoted to co-curricular and extracurricular activities
- The student community of the college predominantly are from rural background, so their aspirations and career goals are very limited.
- Transfer of teaching and administrative staff on year basis effect negatively the development of the college.

Institutional Opportunity

- Industry oriented courses can be designed to ensure employability
- Opportunity for supplementing the core faculty through a system of visiting faculty (including faculty from industries)
- Scope for improving opportunities for learning management system, fully exploiting the e-learning resources
- Opportunity for institutional tie-up – industry linkages for strengthening teaching learning and also for field exposure to the students/faculty
- Being a college in the rural area and run by the government, it has a potential for growing into a centre of excellence in any branch of study. Further the diversity of the programmes in the college enables to cater to the higher study needs of students from any branch: humanities/ science/commerce.
- The locality and neighbouring community of the college need active intervention in their academic, social, cultural and economic domains. This gives the college opportunities for various outreach programmes.

- To build more academic and non-academic blocks by using the funds from KIIFB of Kerala Government.
- To renovate college canteen, women amenity center, boys' amenity center.
- To improve teaching learning process through the extensive use of ICT gadgets and LMS.
- To train the faculty in the effective use of LMS tools in teaching process in the context of pandemic
- To improve the achievement of students in sports and arts in national and international level.
- To collaborate with universities, institutions and industry to share the infrastructure and academic facilities through faculty and students exchange.
