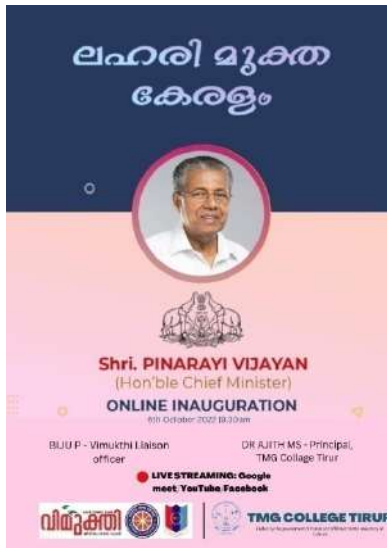

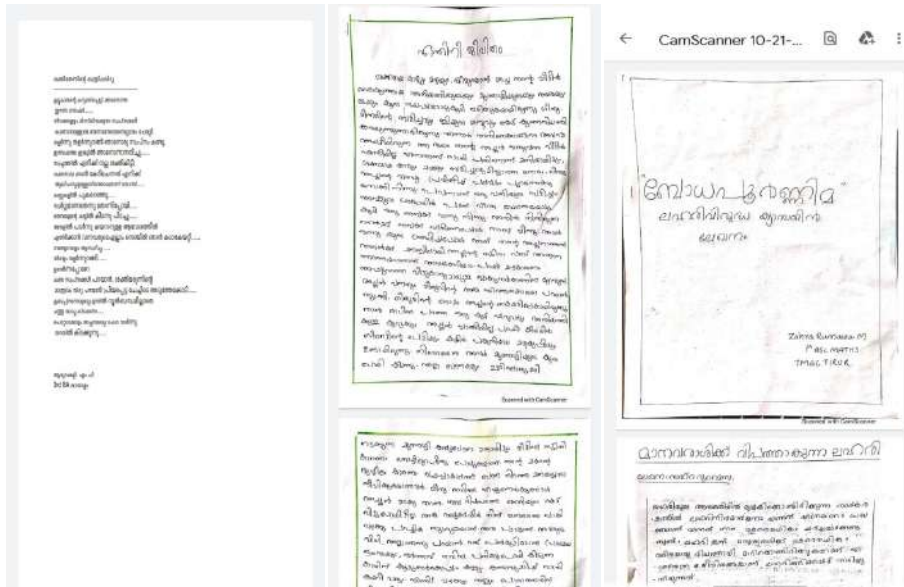
NSS cell. Ten students were participated in the quiz. Out of this two students who scored highest were nominated for the district level quiz competition

Human Chain:

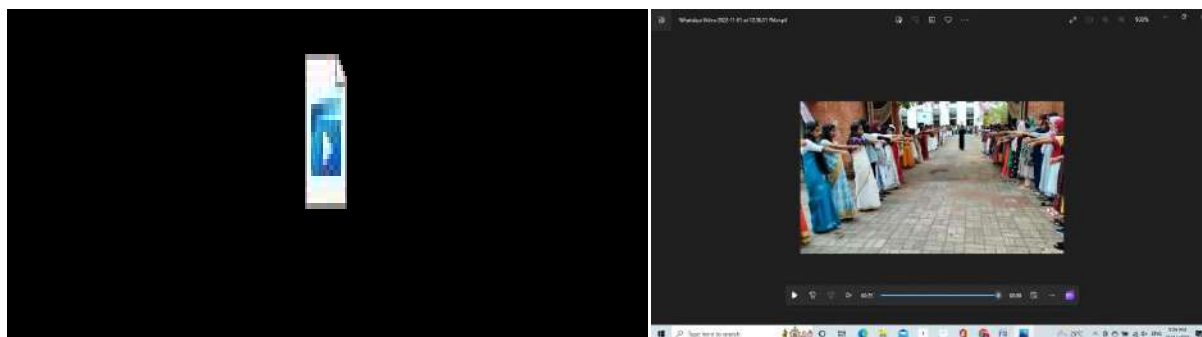
The human chain was formed by the Students and staff of the college to create awareness against drugs.
