### **NCC Closing Ceremony (23/3/2018)**

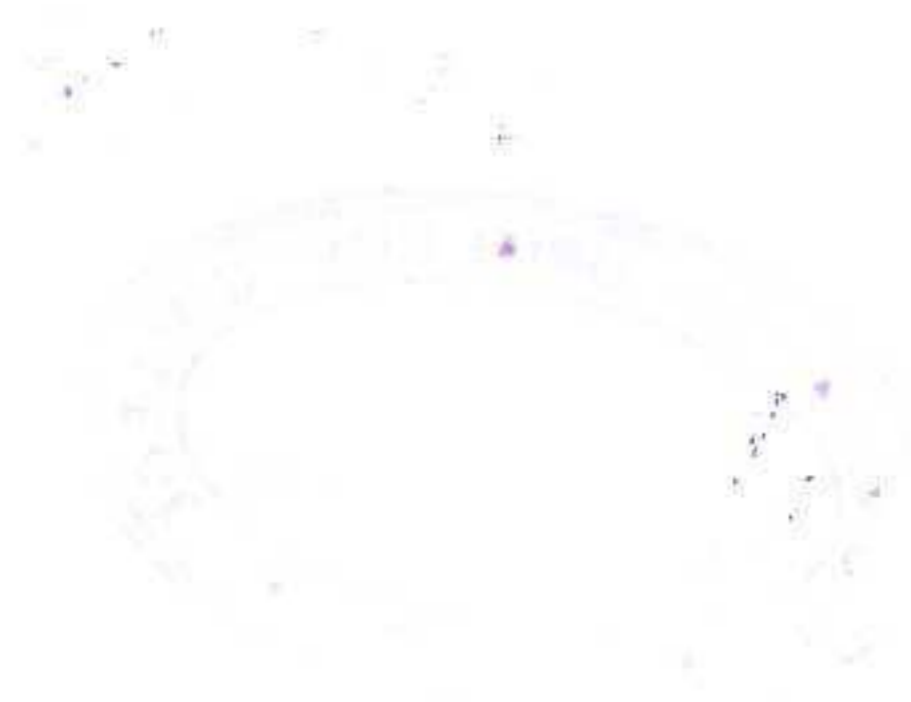

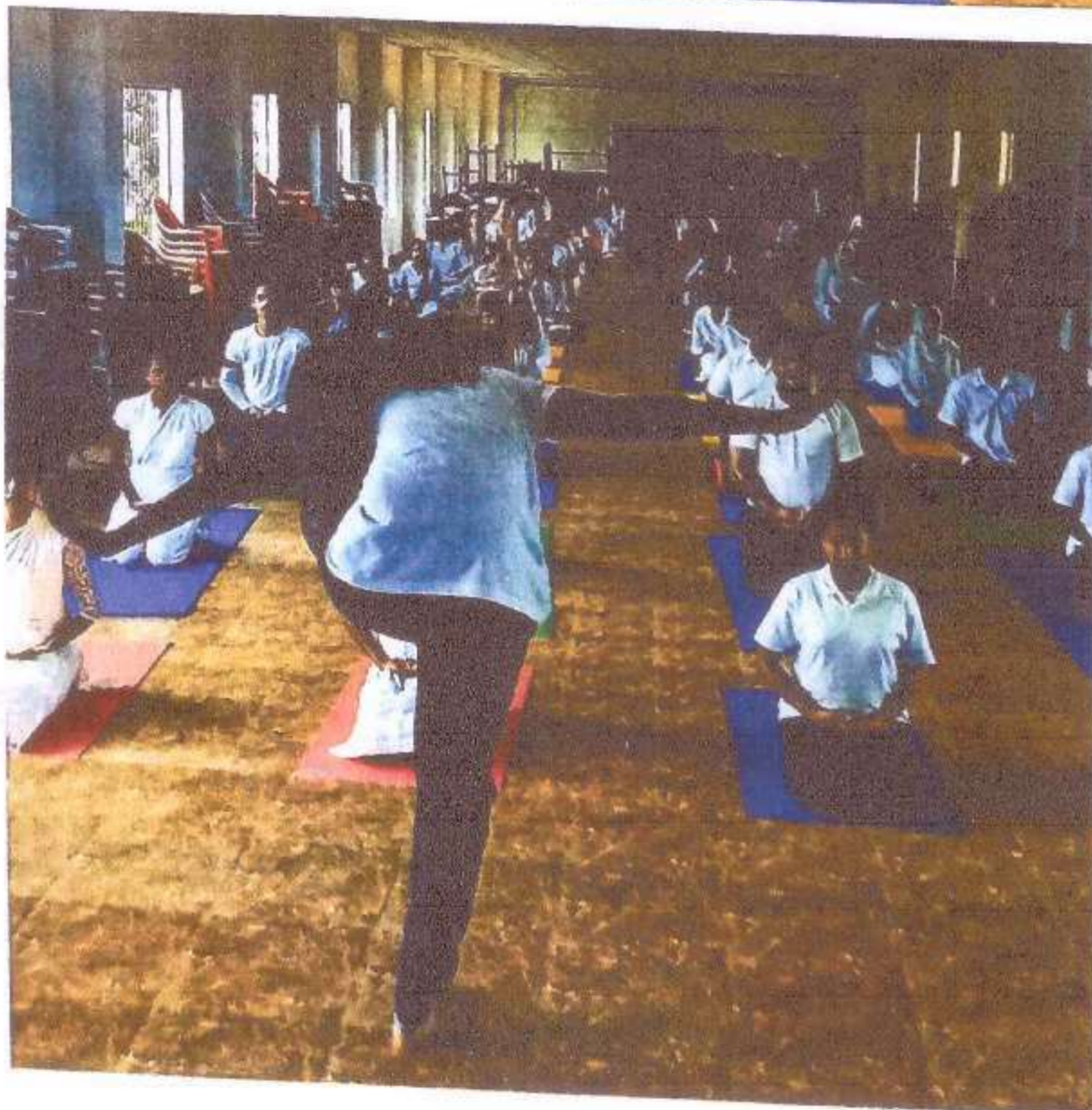
## **05.05.2017 - Disaster Management Training Camp**

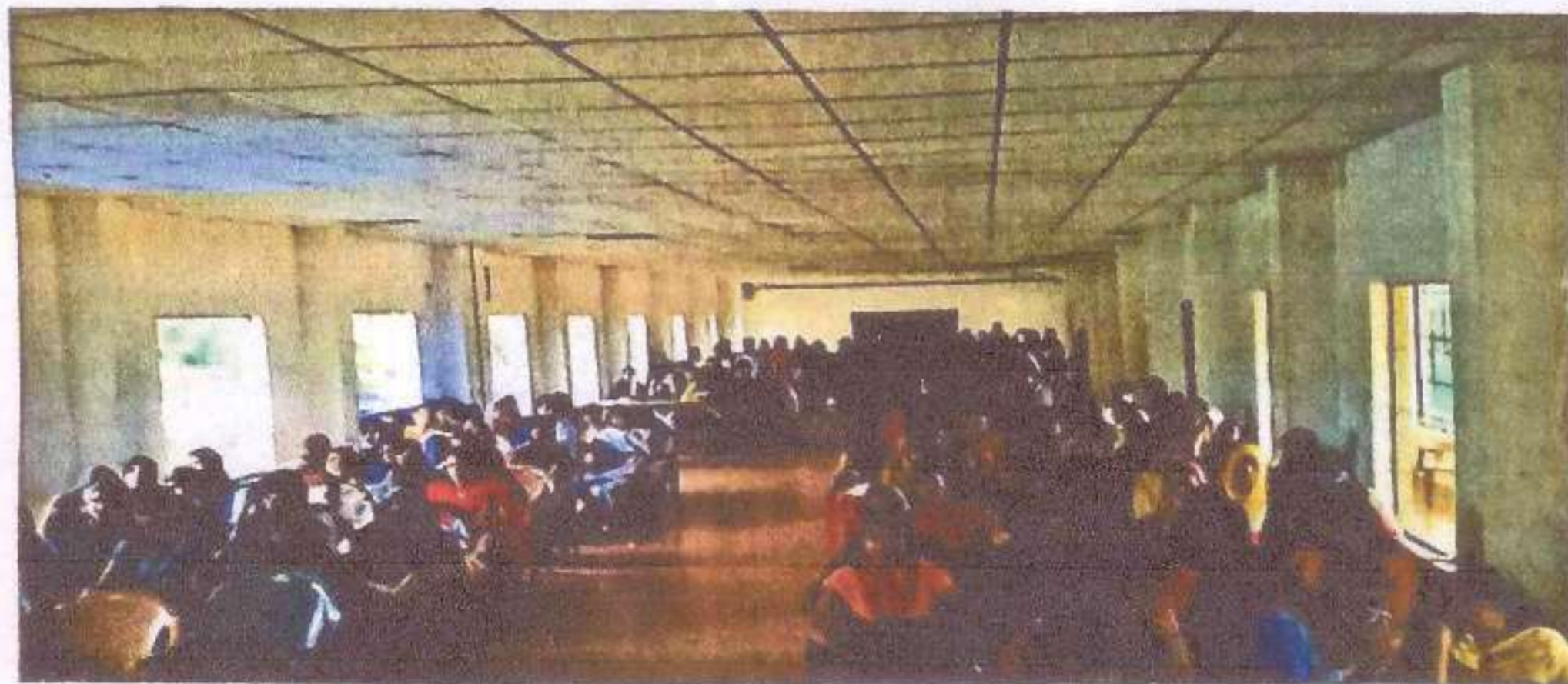
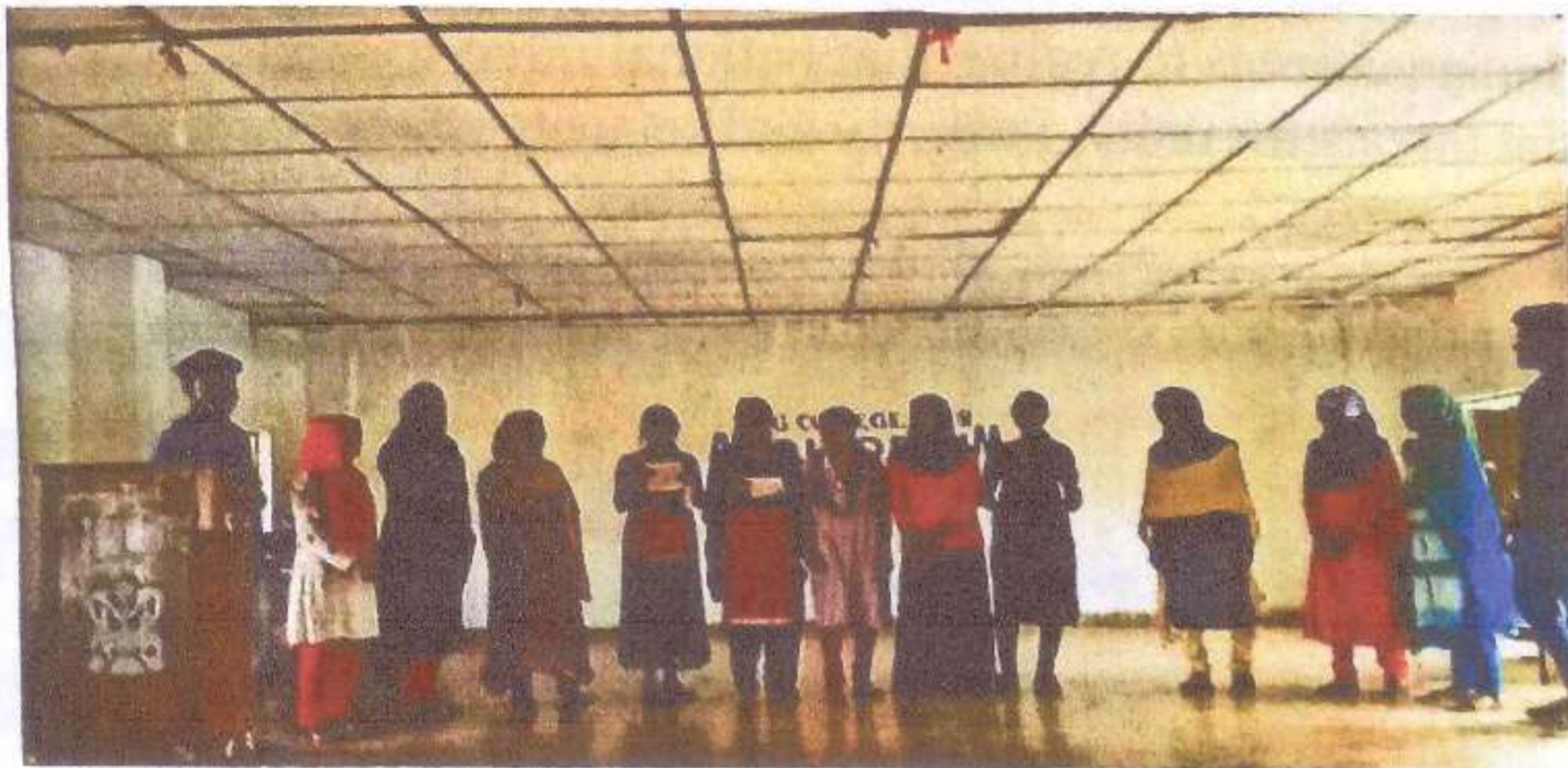
## October 31<sup>st</sup> - 2017 - National Unity Day/ RashtriyaEktaDiwas

**Introduction:**

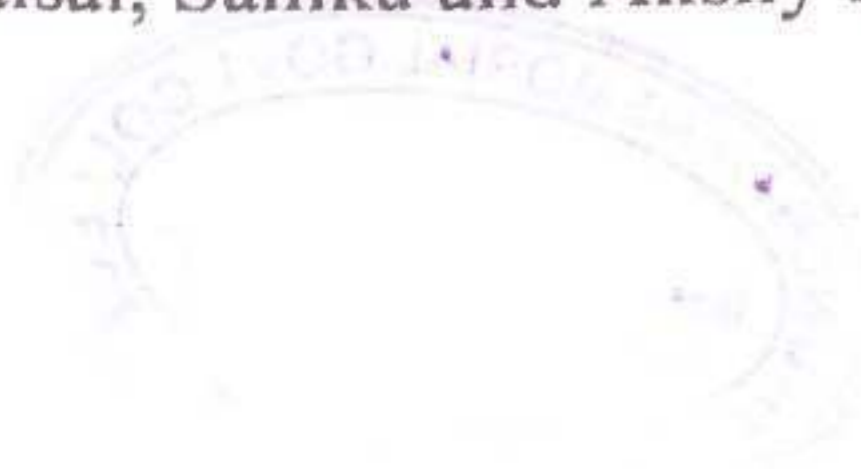
