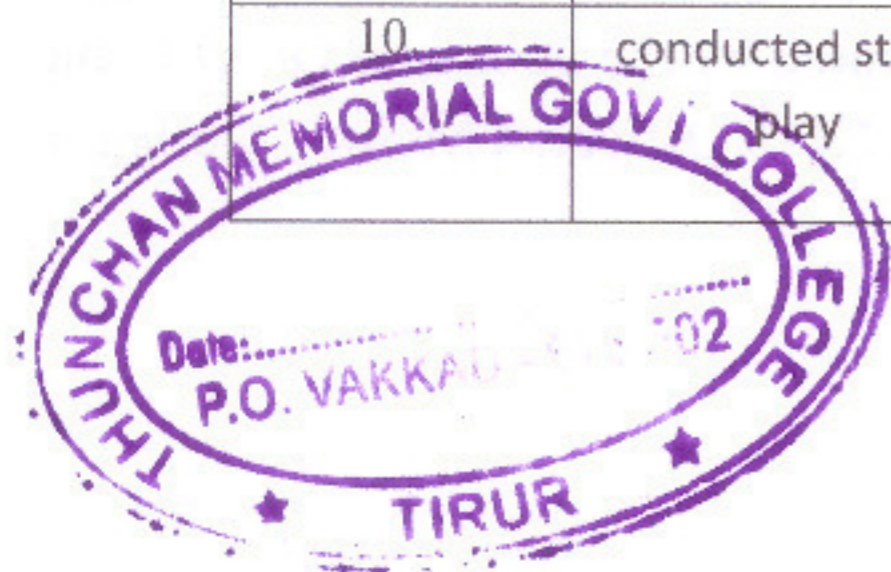

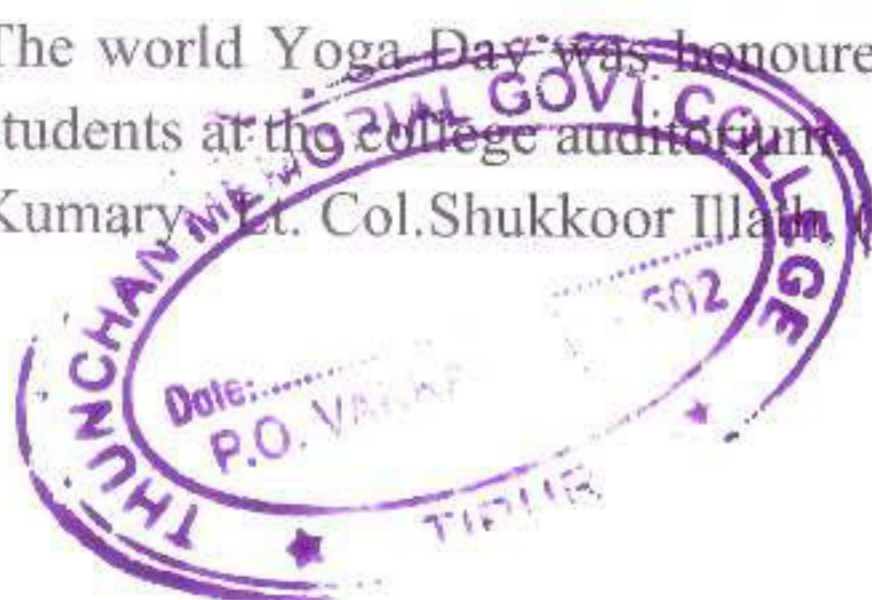
The report of the activities of the unit for the academic year 2018-19 has been a record of accomplishments and triumphs.

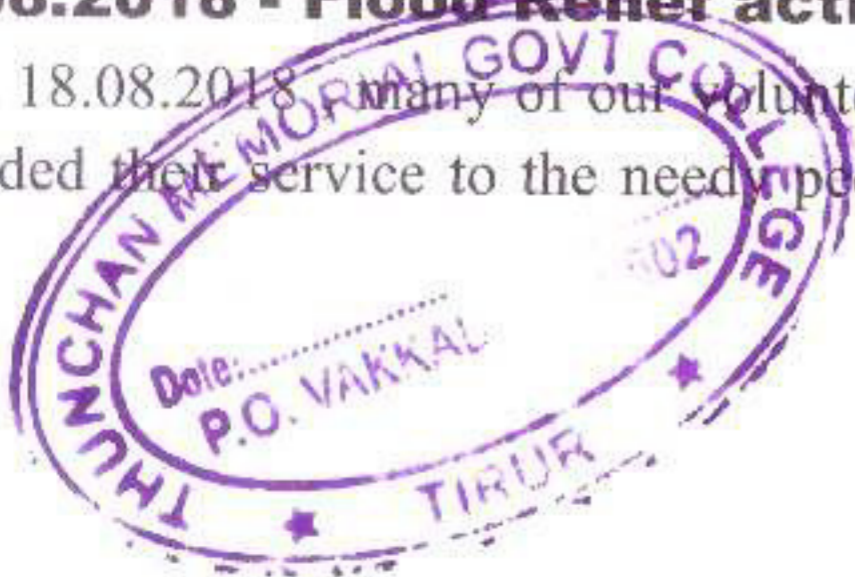
15.08.2018 - Independence day

The unit organised a blood donation camp in association with the HDFC Bank. 26 volunteers donated their blood as a part of the camp.

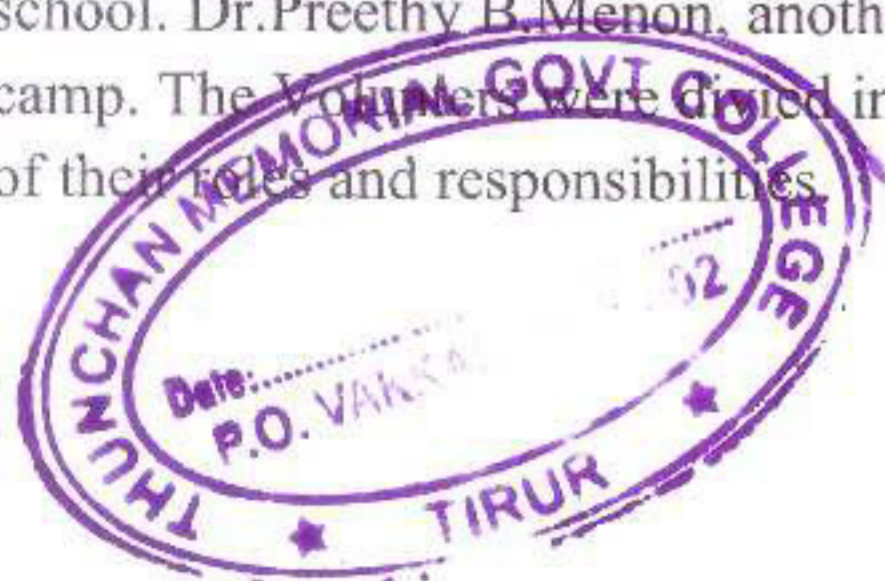
4 volunteers of our Units gave blood on the spot to the needy patients admitted in various Hospitals in the last year.

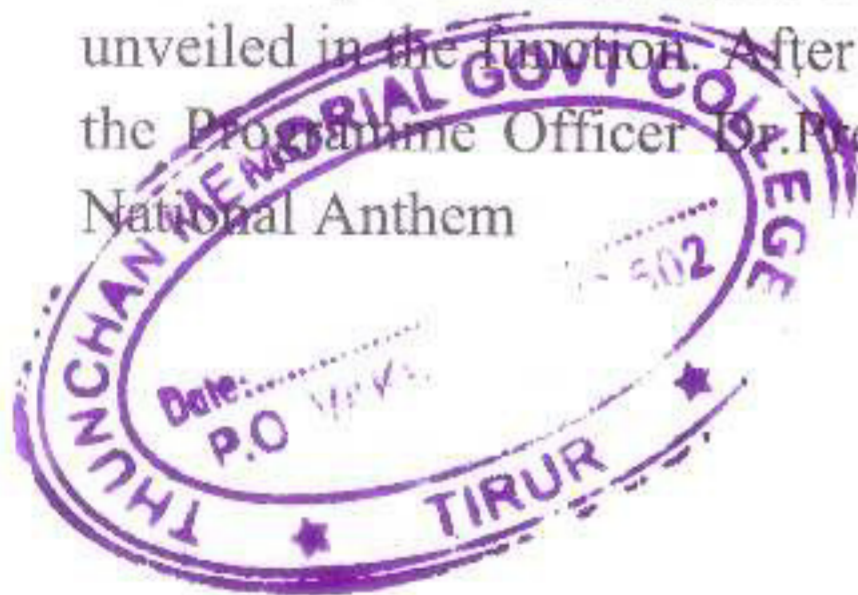

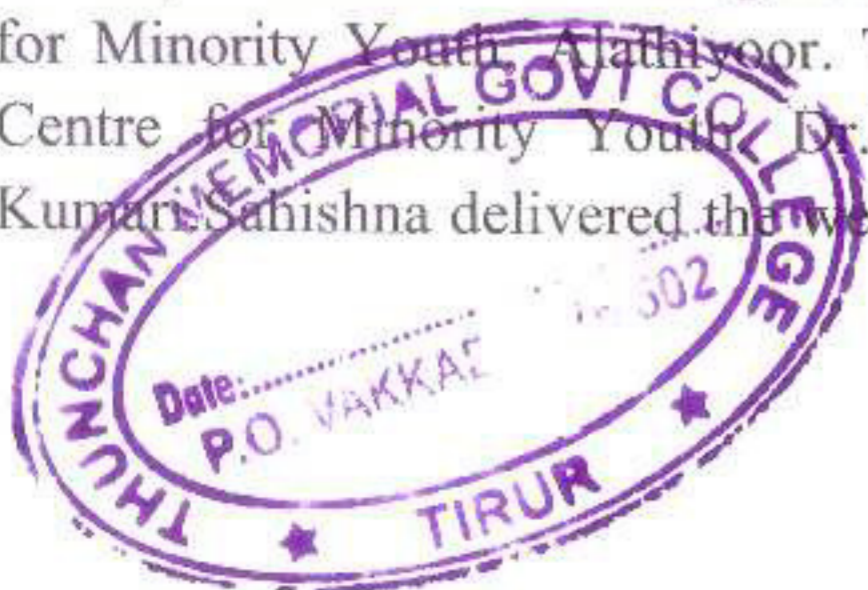

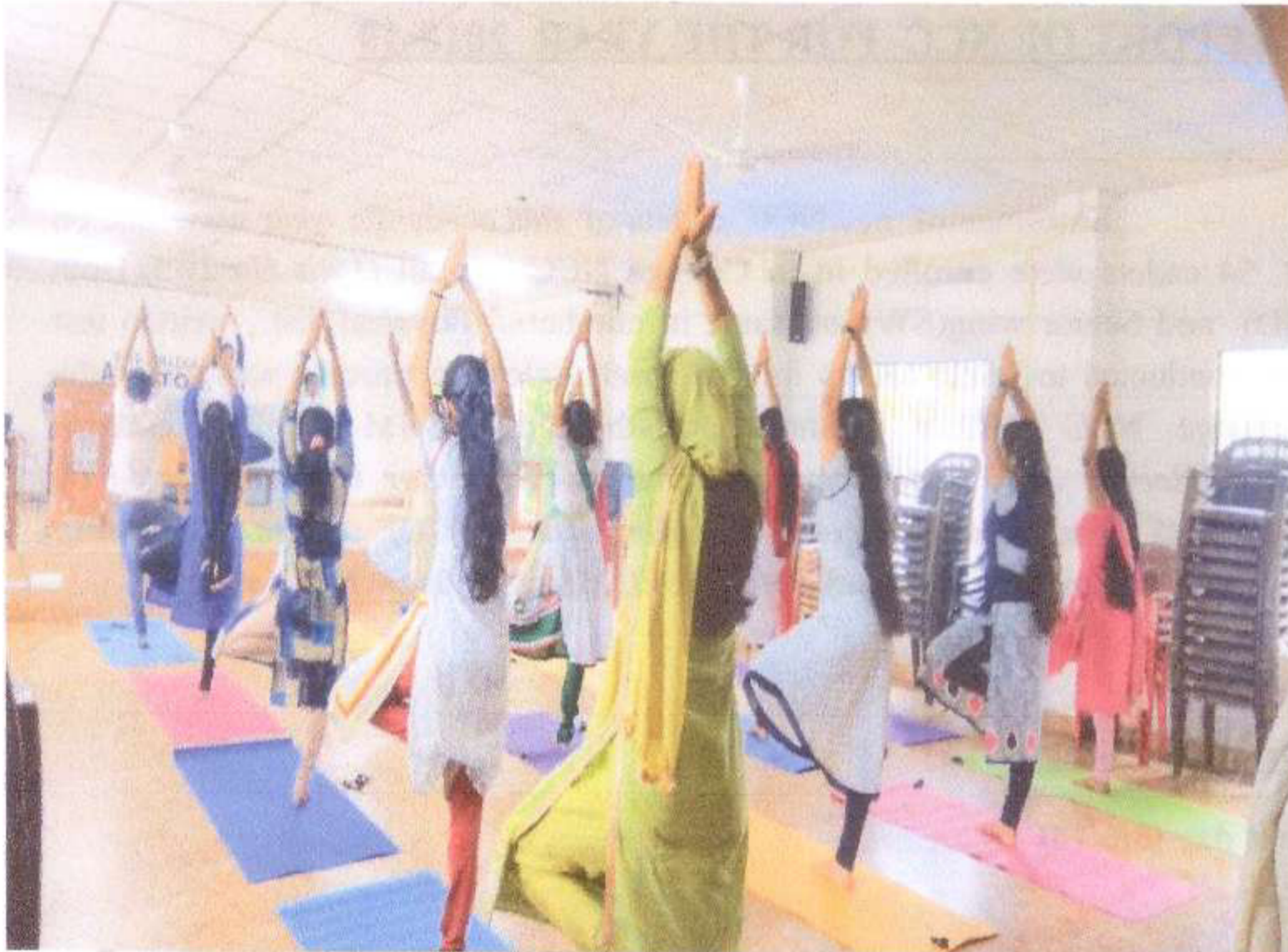
World Environment day (5/6/18)

Girls cadets also were actively participated the village cleaning programme .College NCC officer was assigned as the liaison officer to District collectorate of 9 refugee camps.

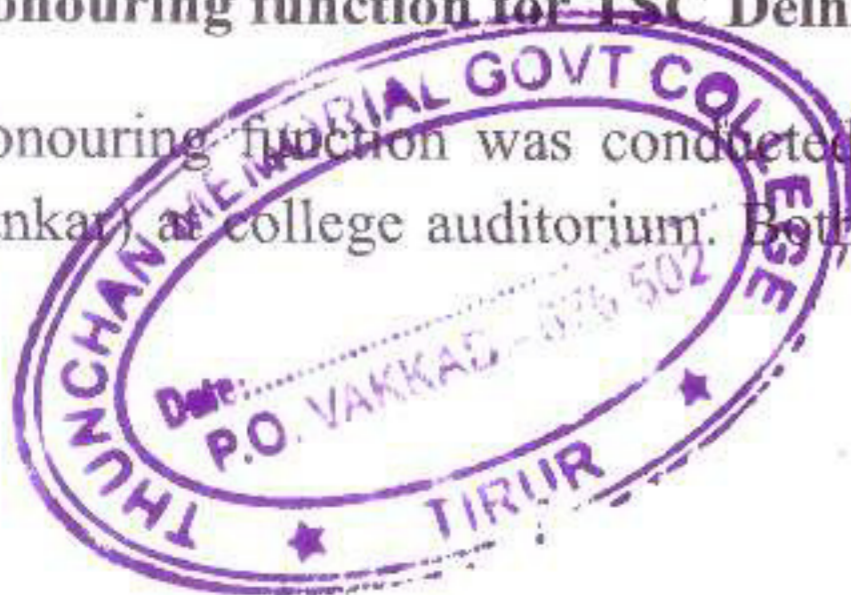
Honouring for flood rescue and refugee camp operation (22/3/2019)

Vetom Santhi special school visit

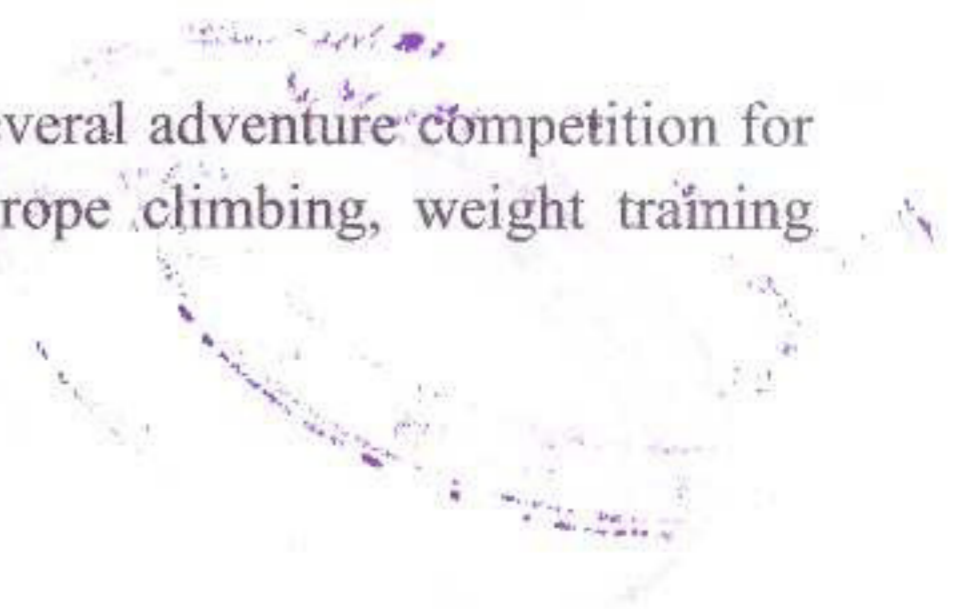
