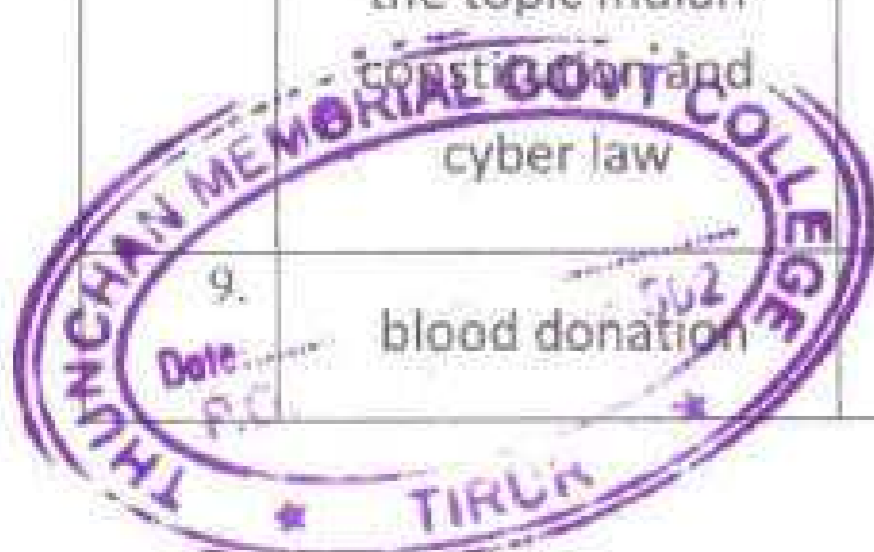

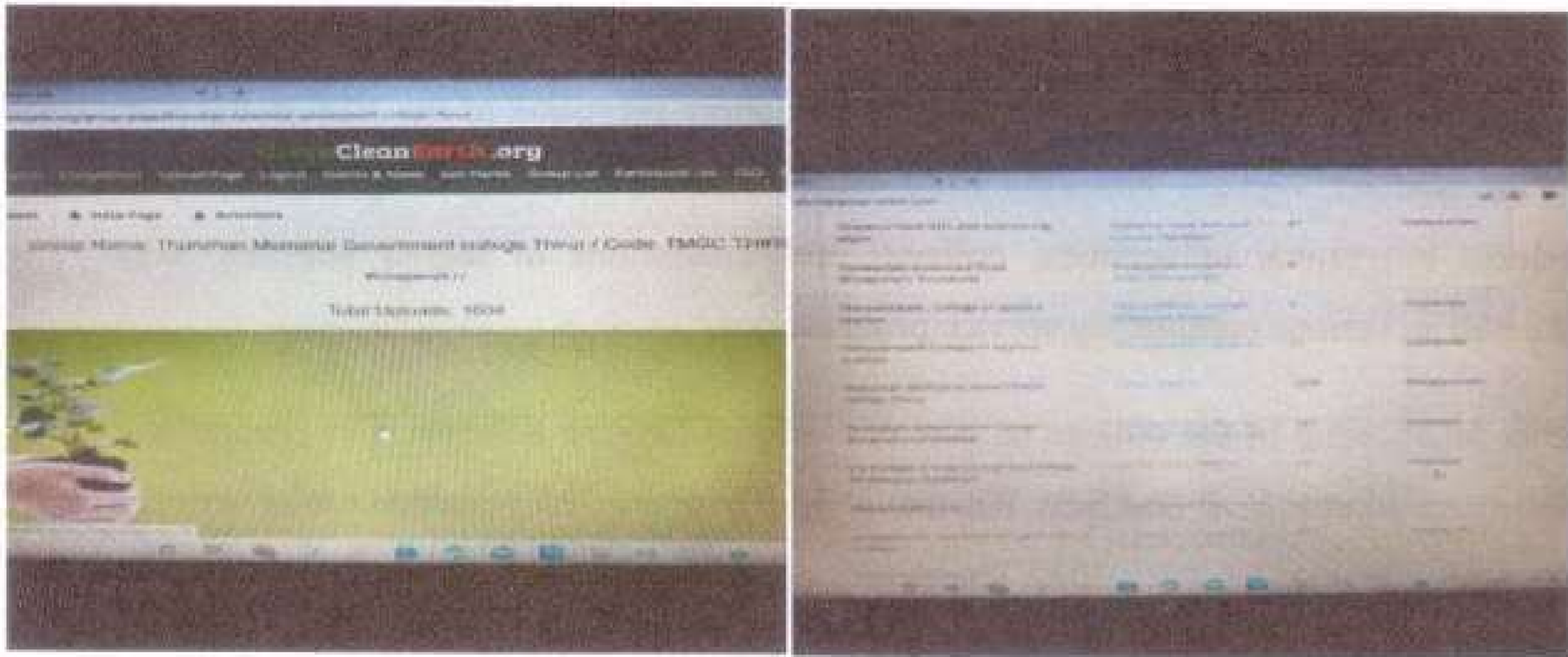
The major activities organized by the NSS units of TMC College during the year were as follows

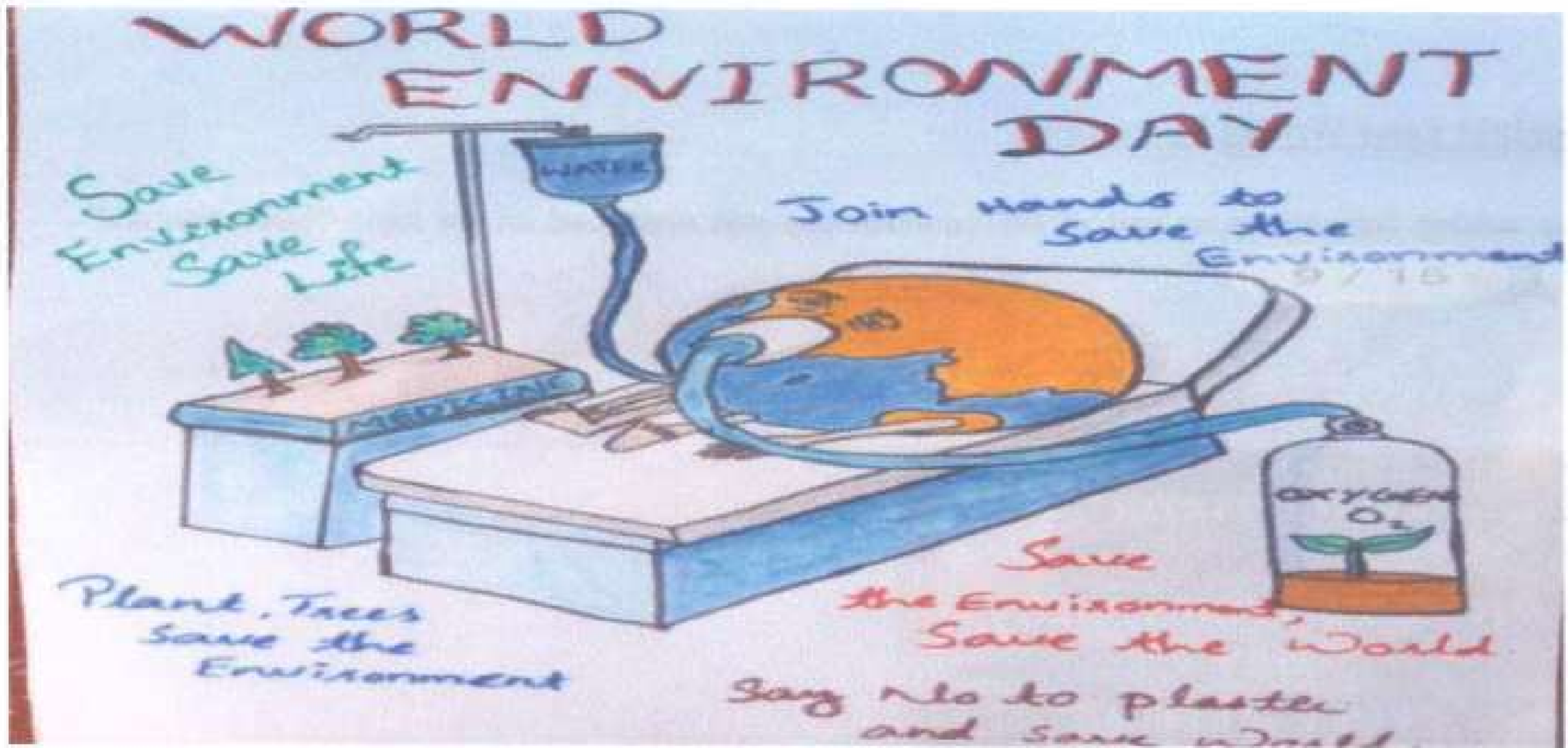


The college level programmes as part of environment day were detailed below

A photography Contest on the theme "Men and Soil" were organised as part of Environment day. The contestants shared their photos through Whats app/ The winners of the competition were .

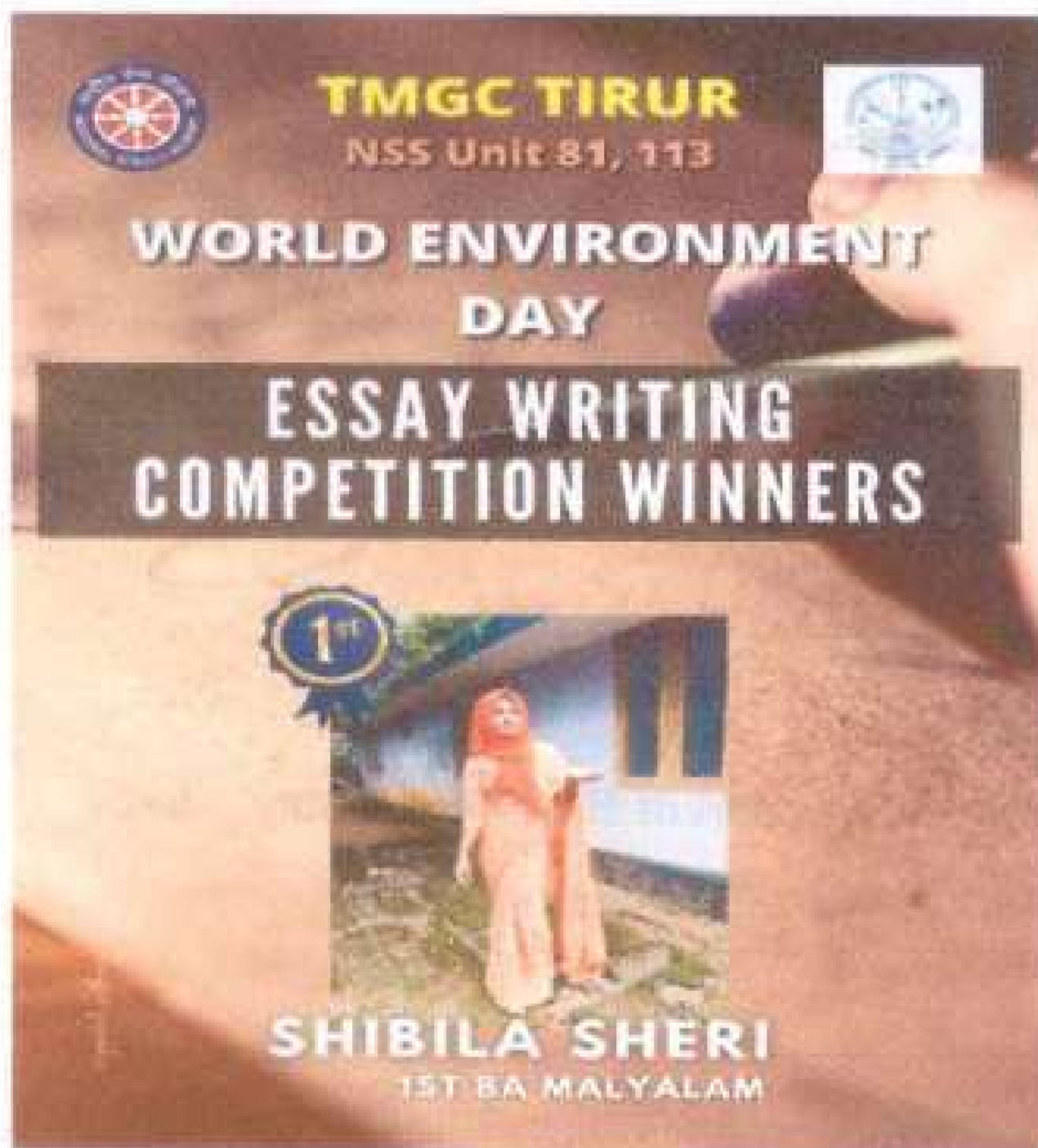

Essay writing competition as part of Environment day was organized on the topic "Education and Covid-19".



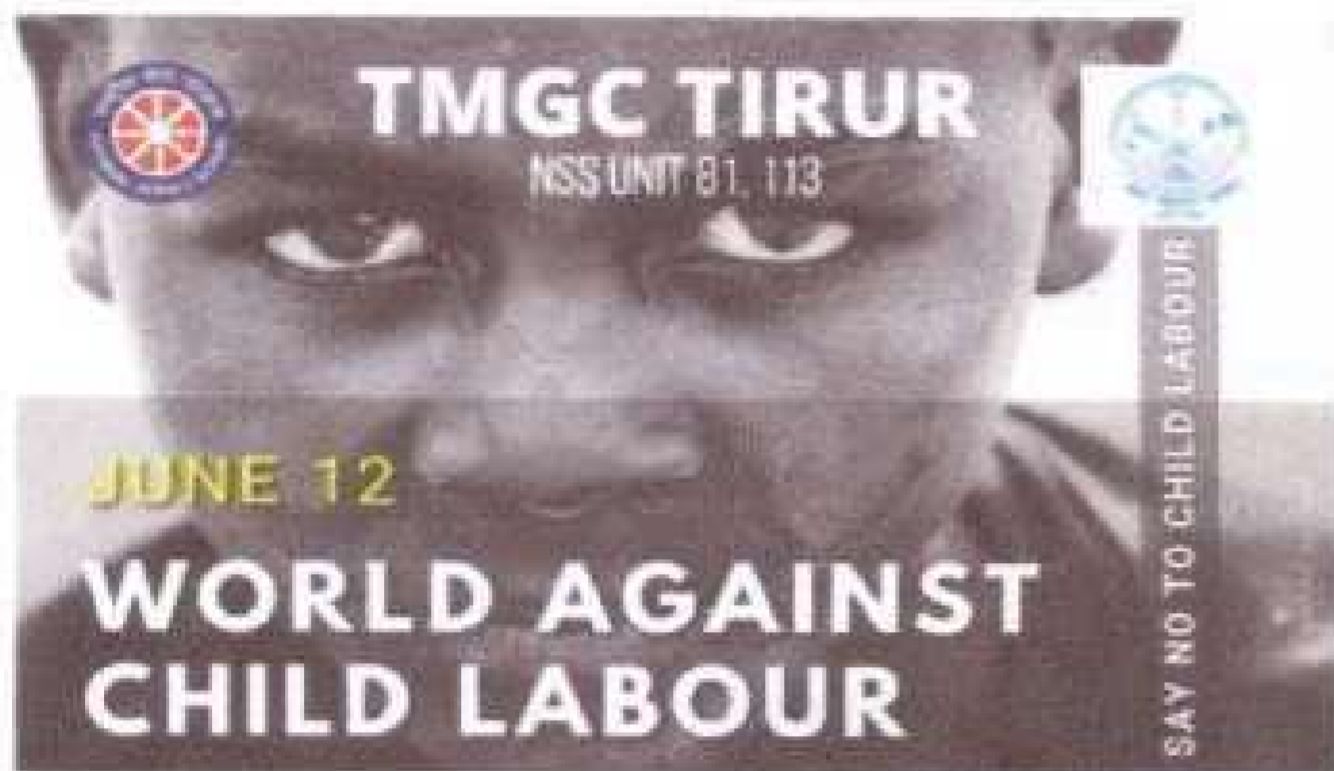

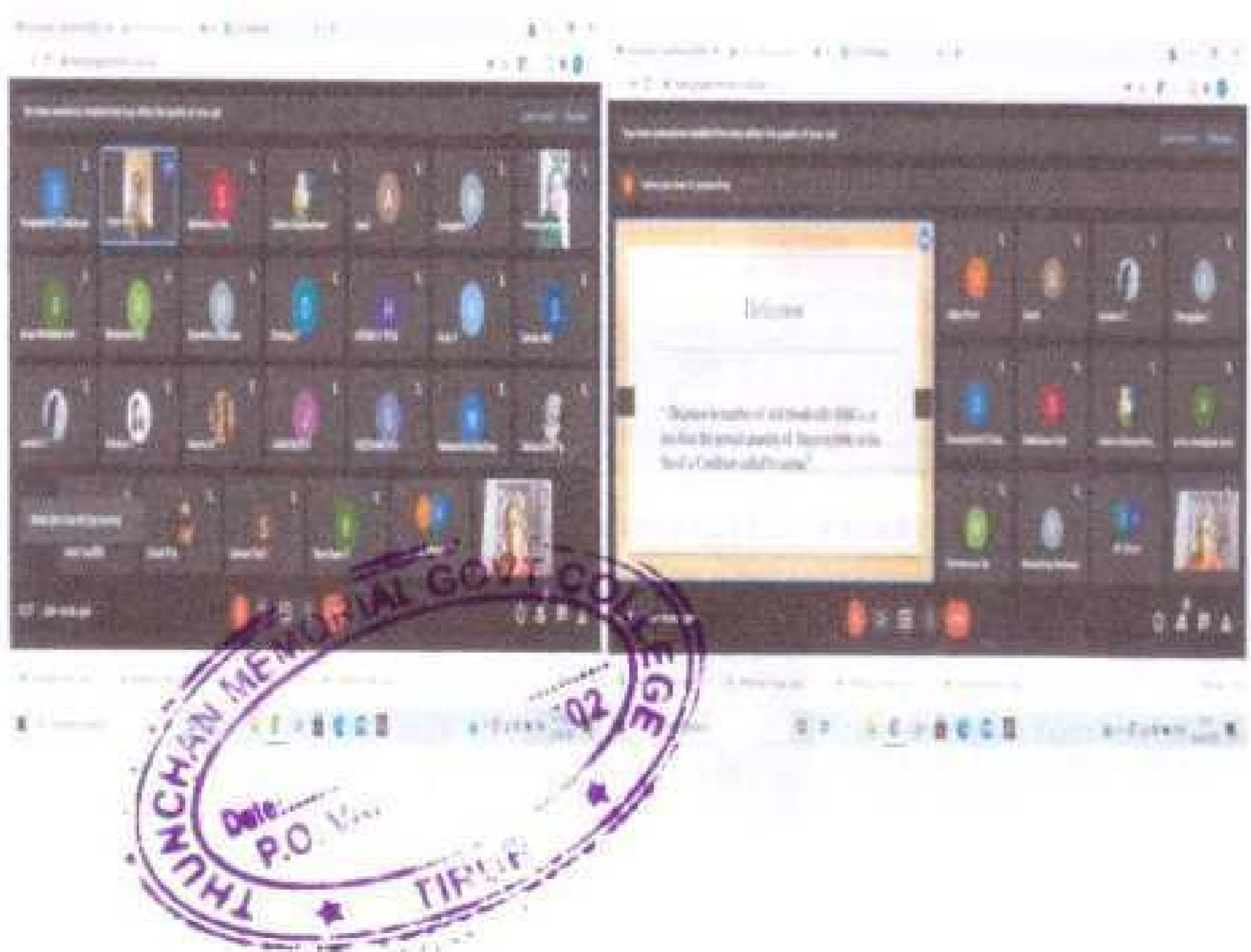

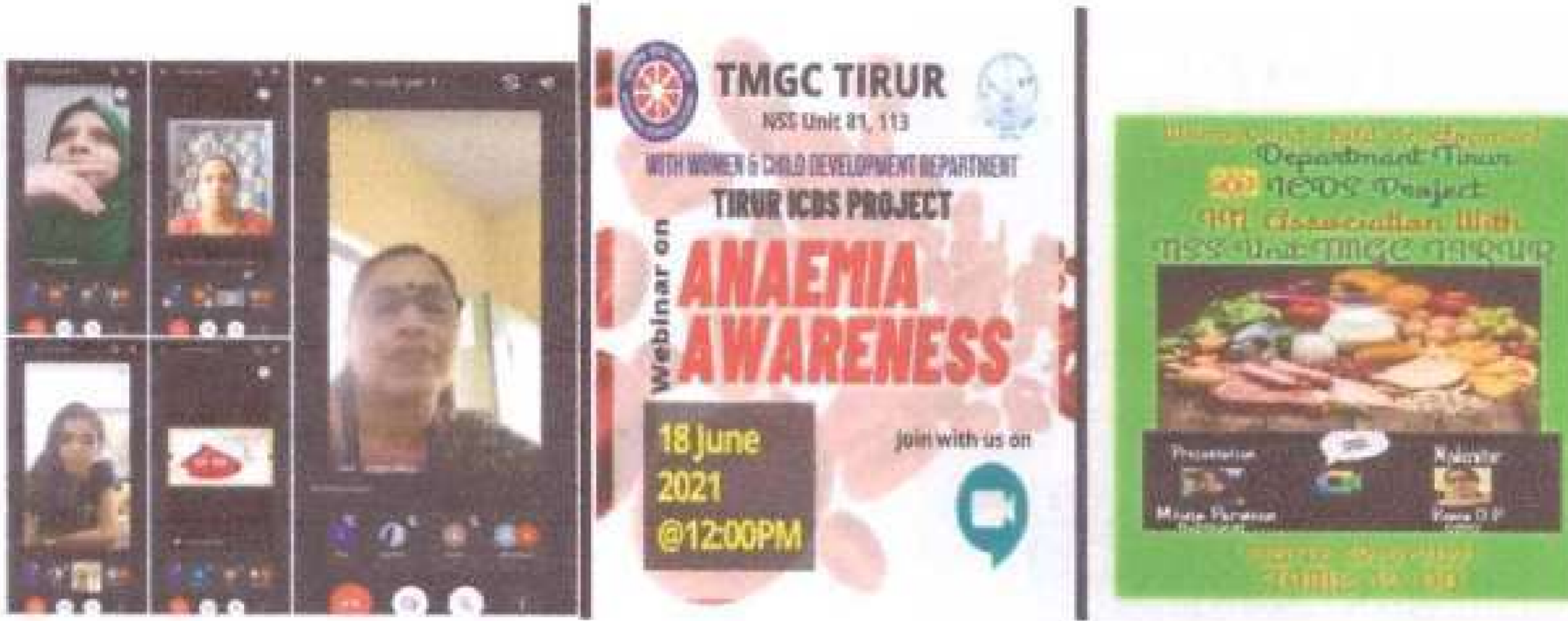

18/06/2021 (Webinar on Anaemia Awareness)

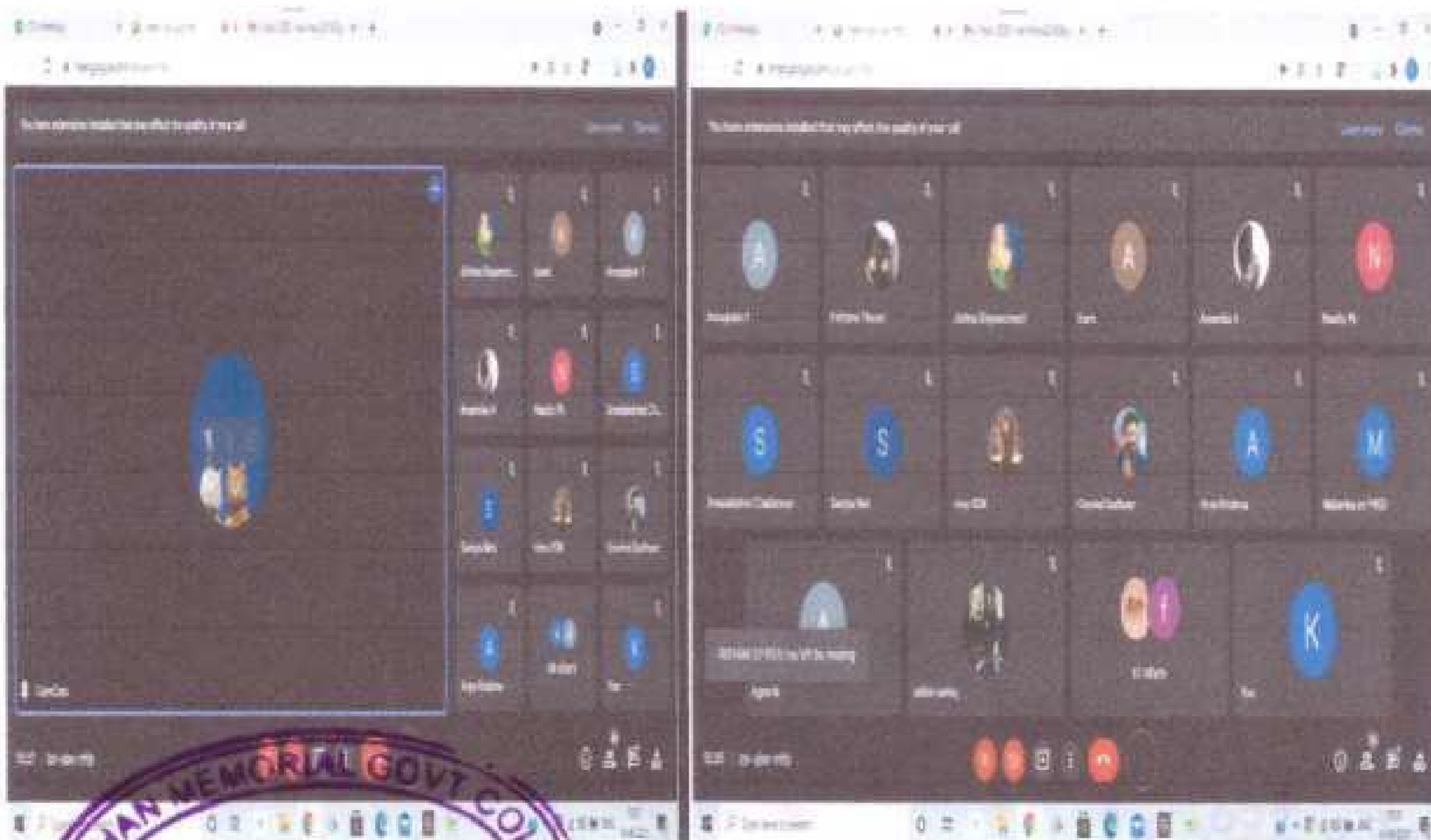

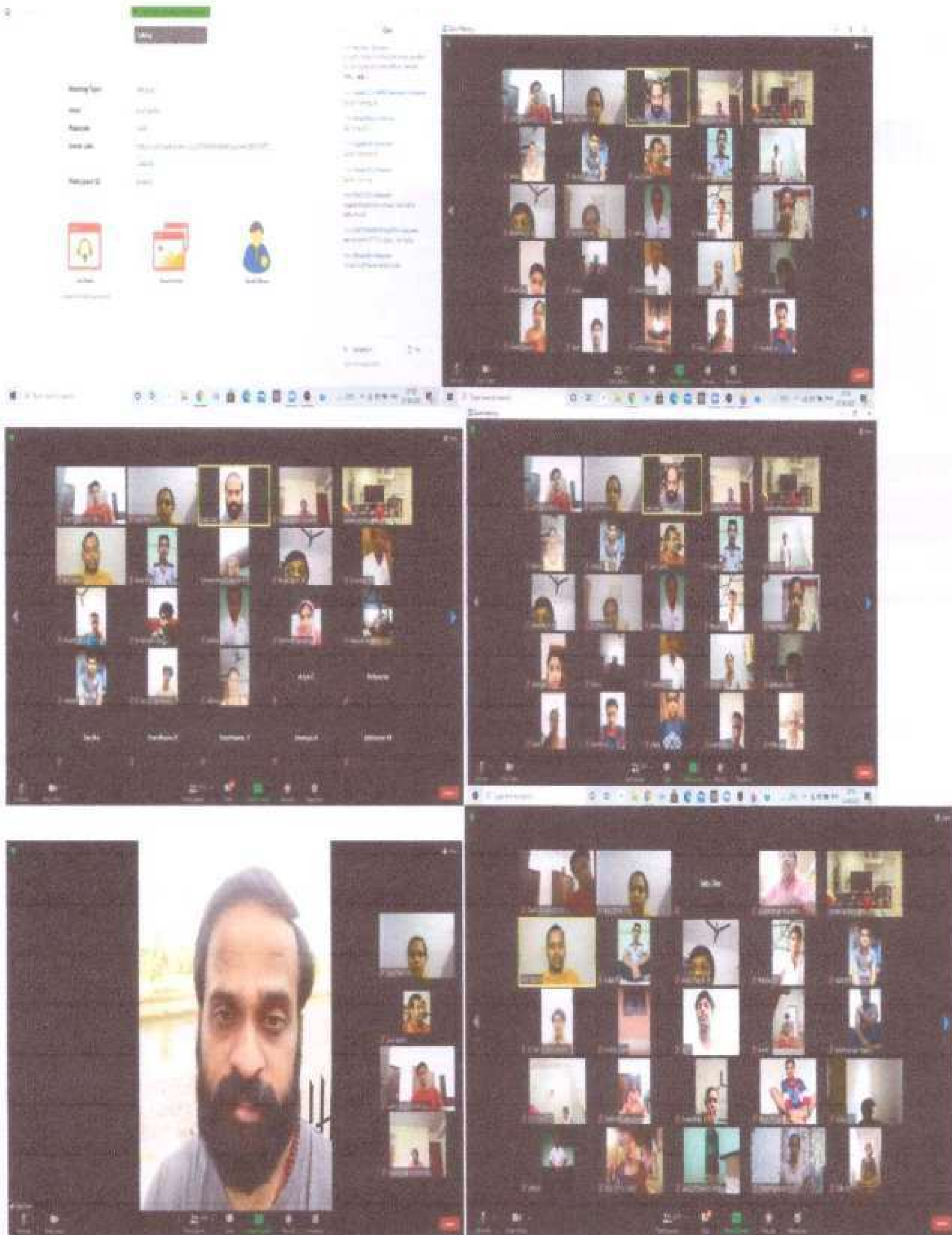

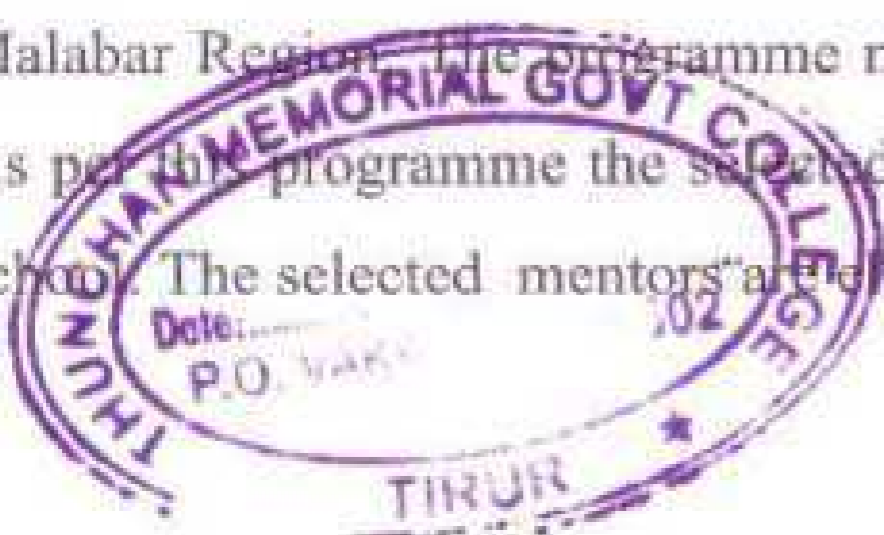

27/06/2021 (Webinar)

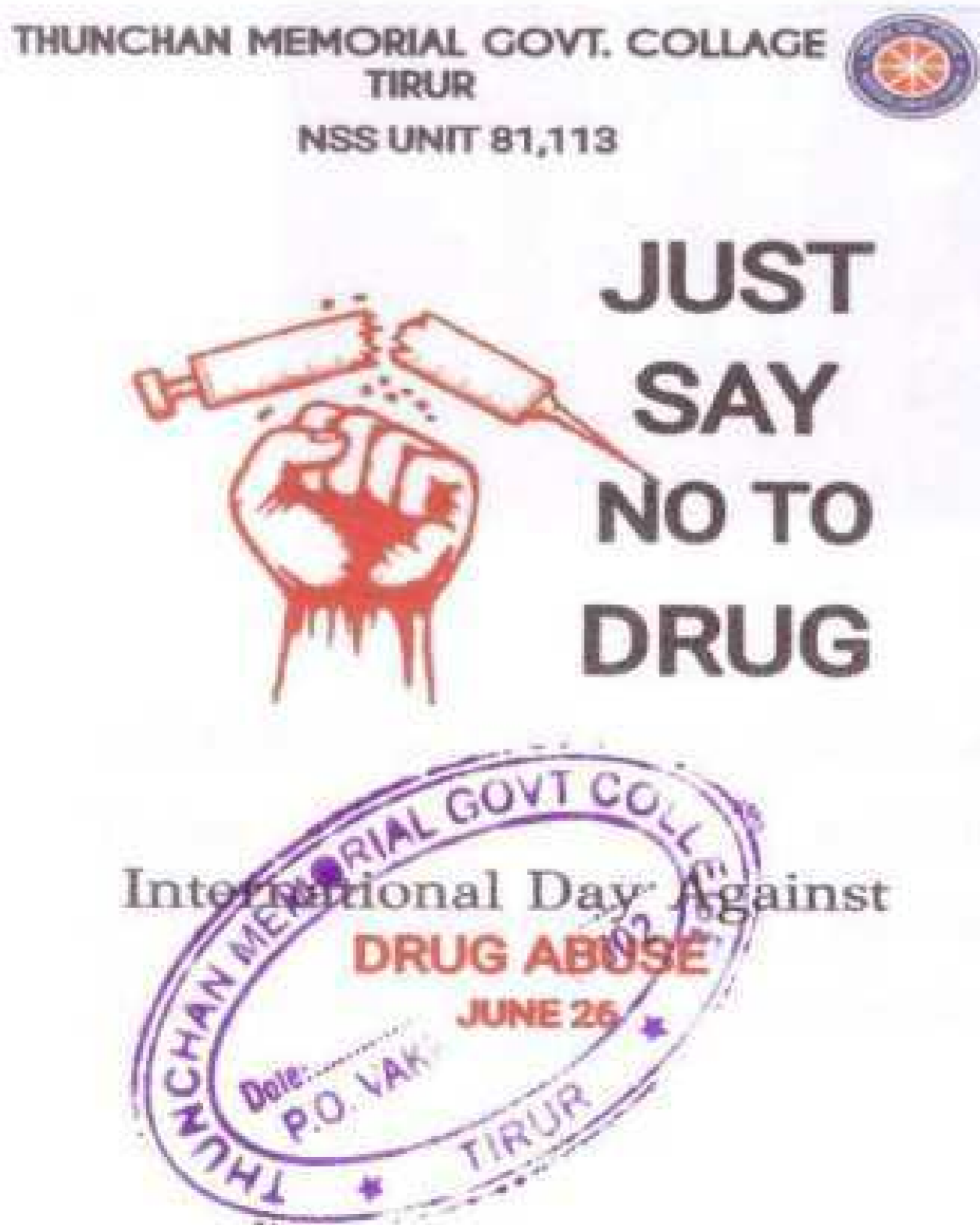

Beach Cleaning 22/11/21

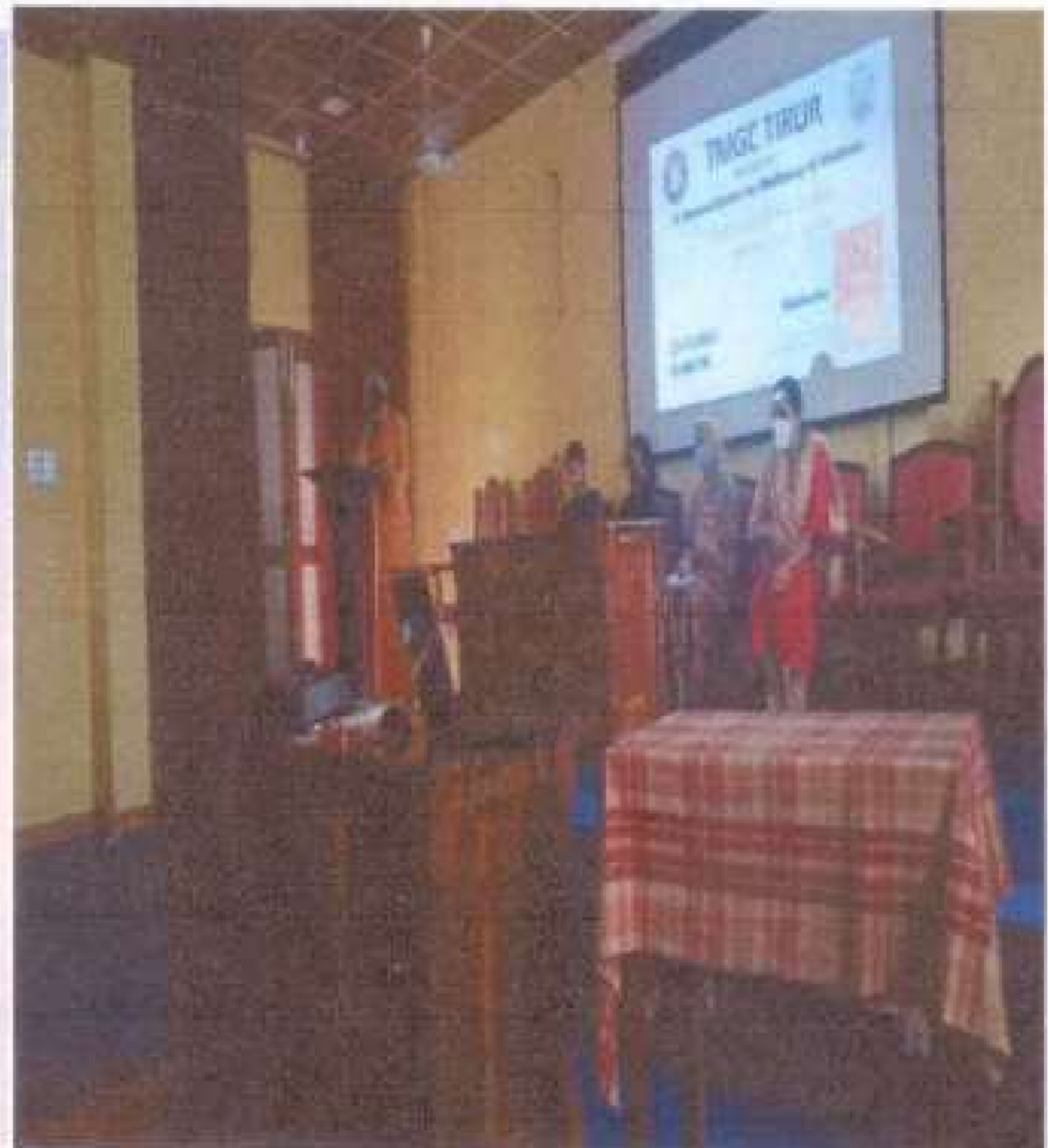

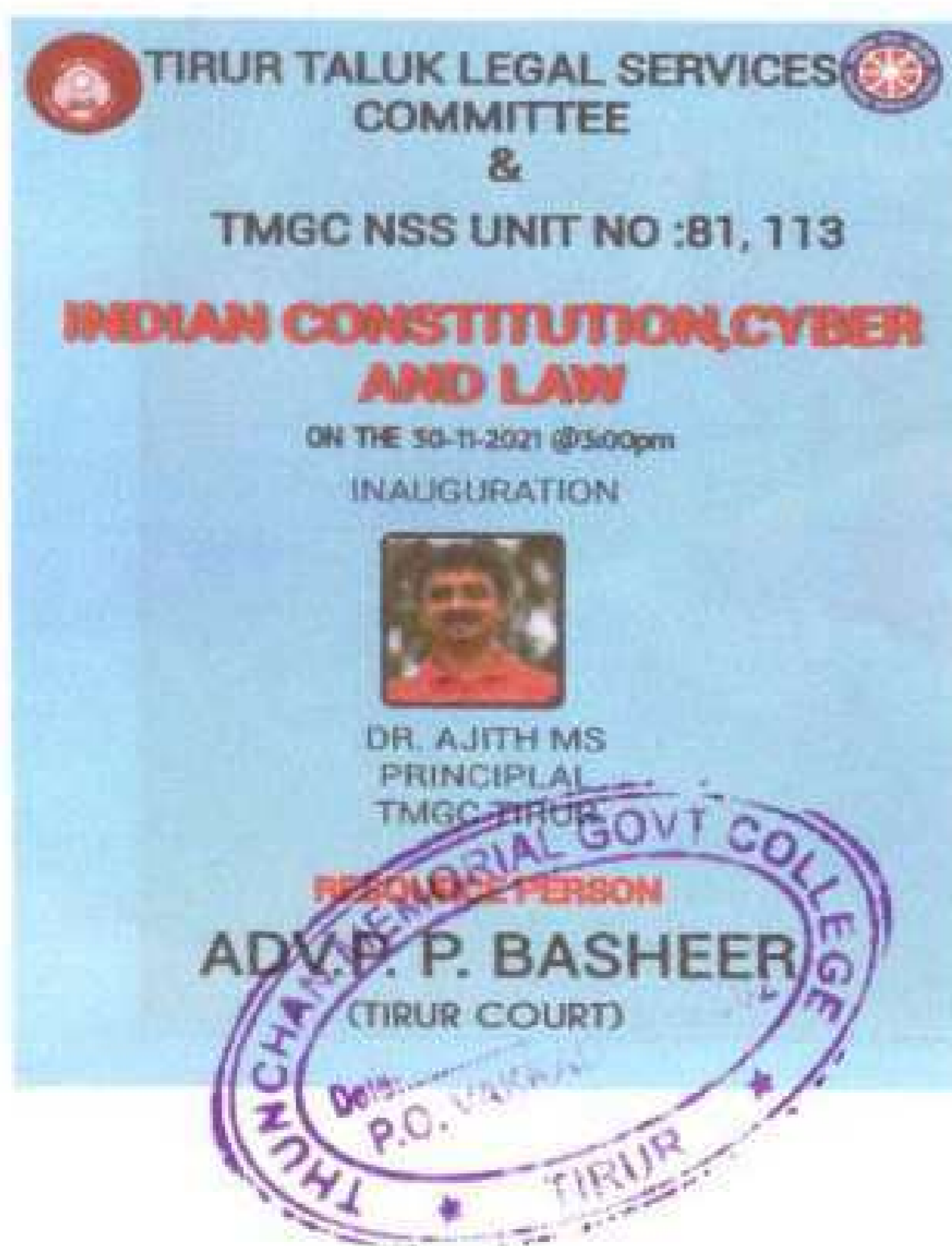

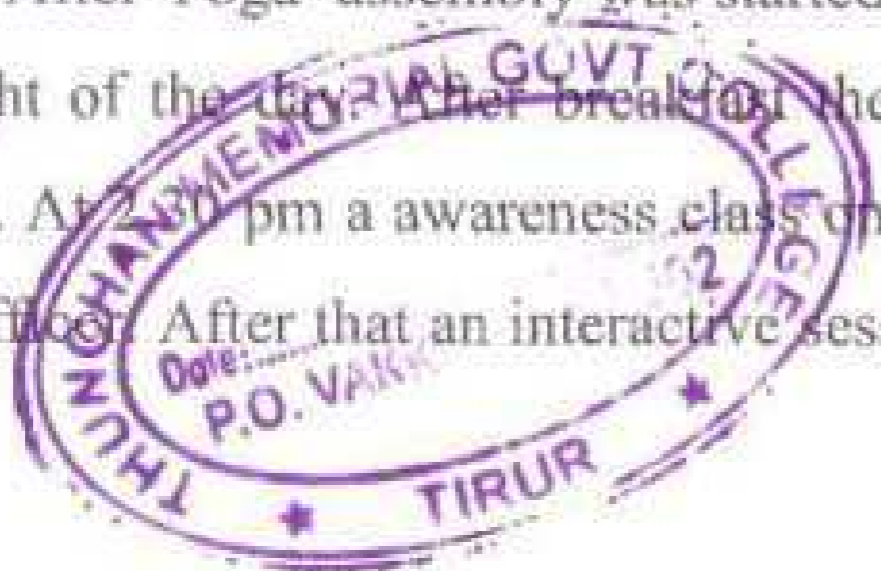






Day 2 (26-12-2021)

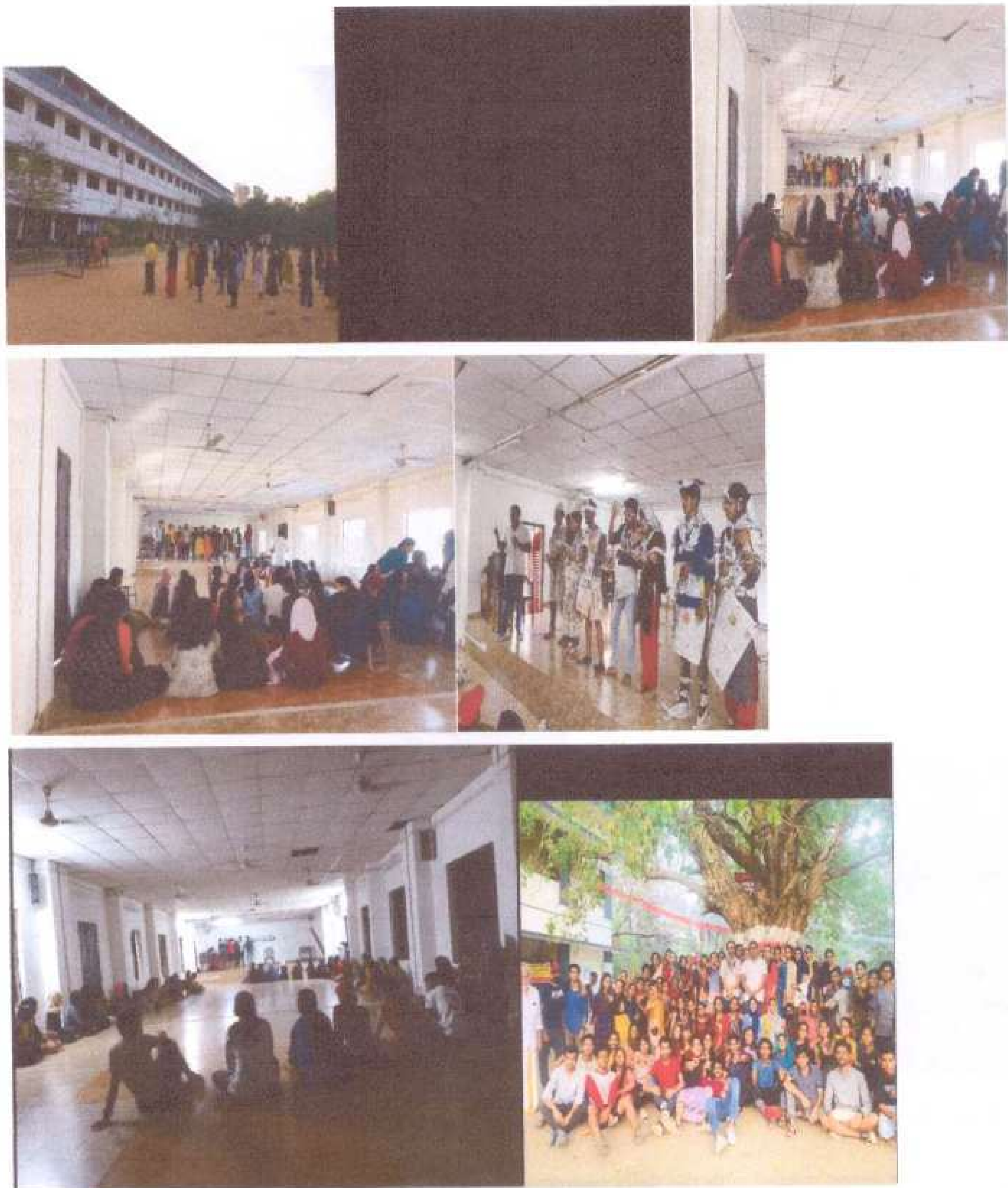
At 6.00 pm cultural programme started. All volunteers actively participated in the programme. The feedback session was there after the cultural programme. After dinner at 10.00pm lights off.



Day 3 (27-12-2021)

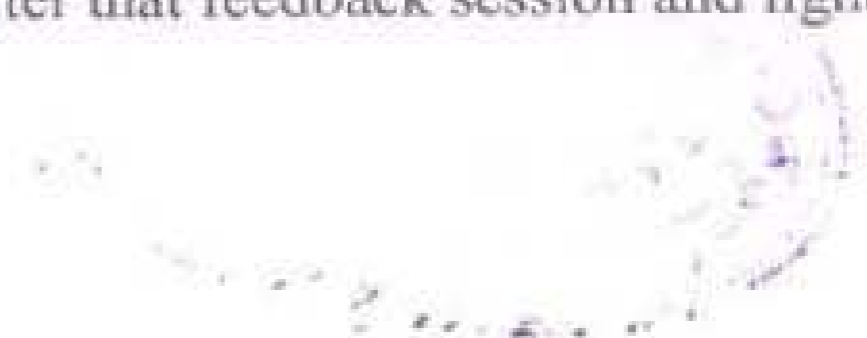

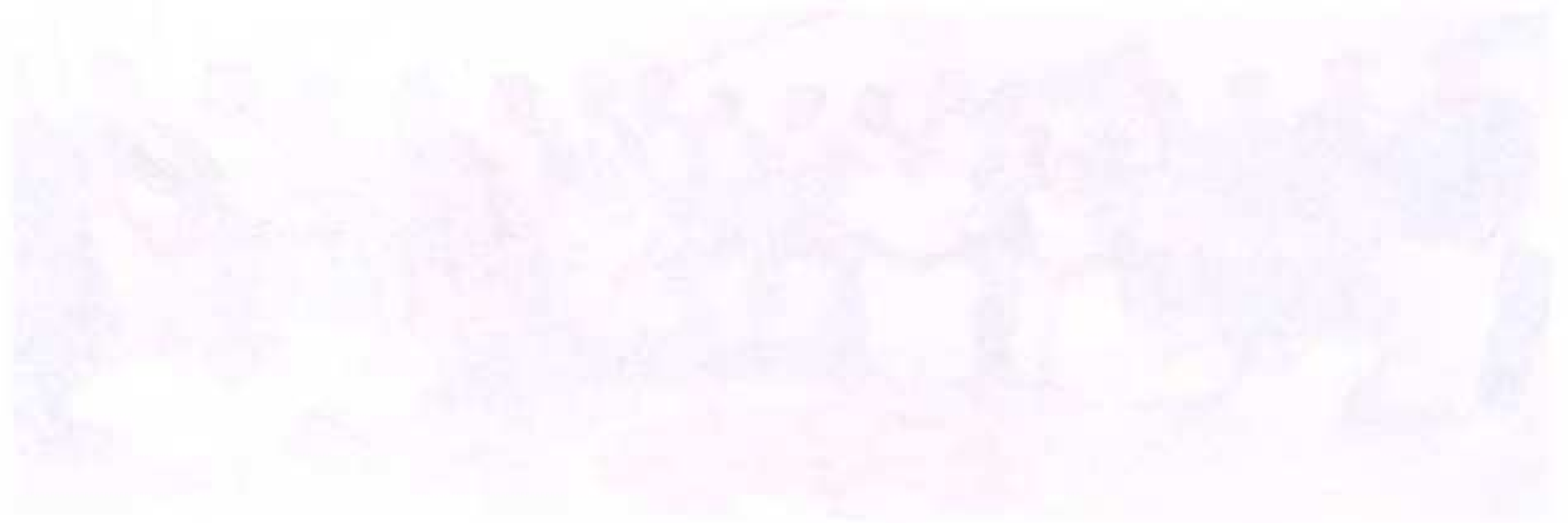
THE FAREWELL..... NCC CLOSING CEREMONY
