

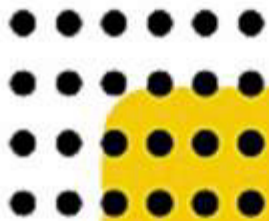

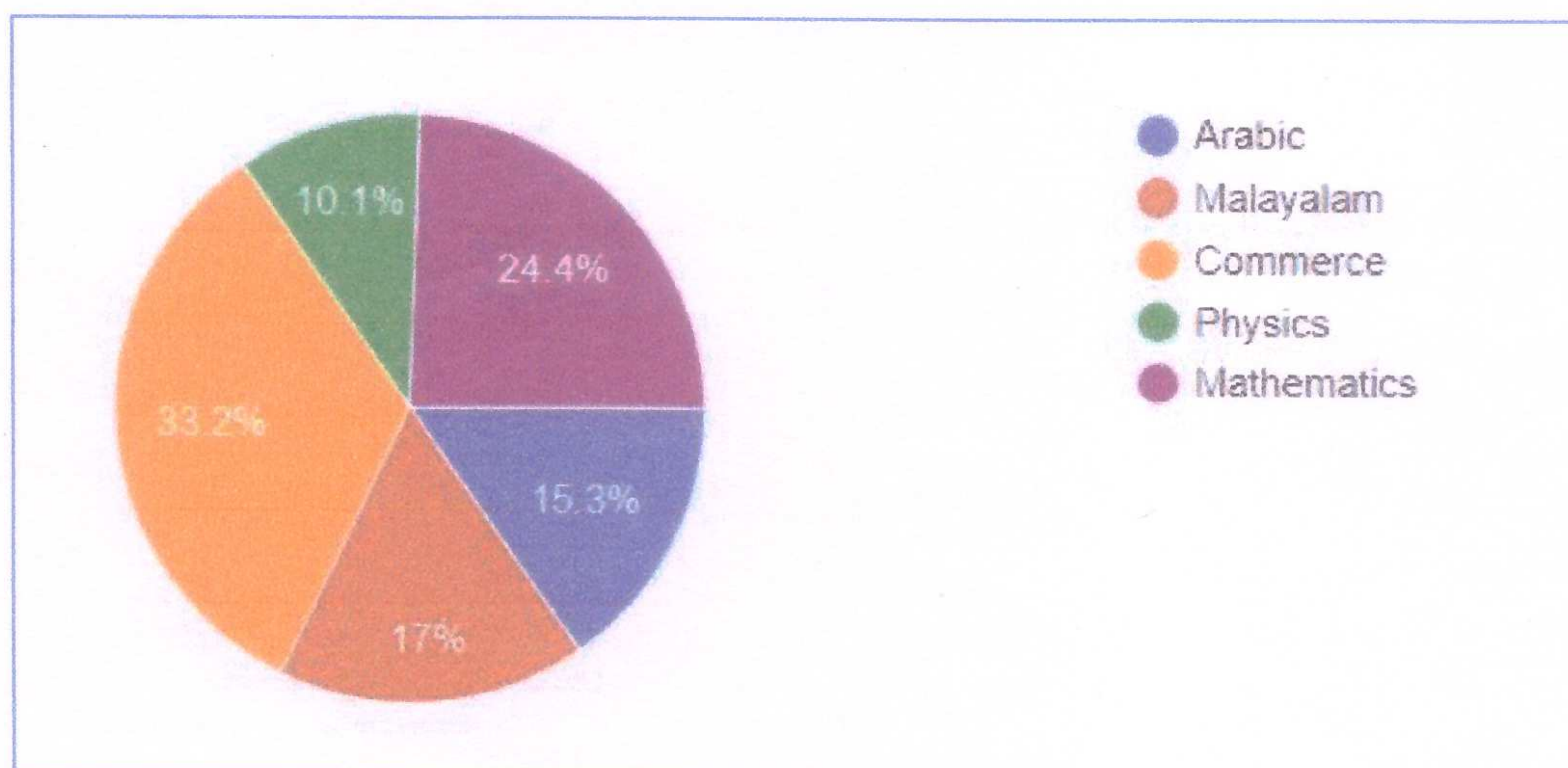

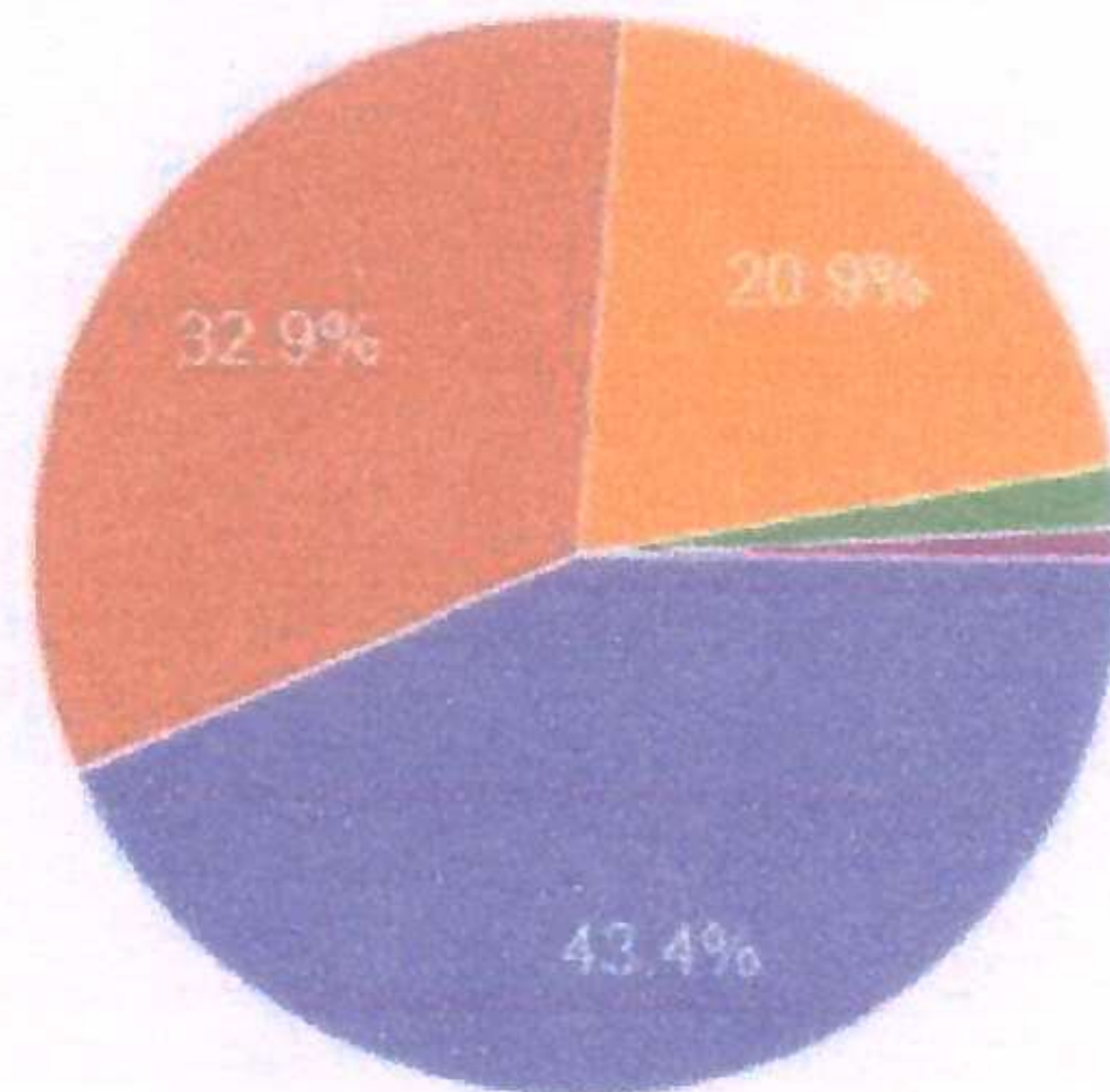

How do you rate the learning environment in the college?

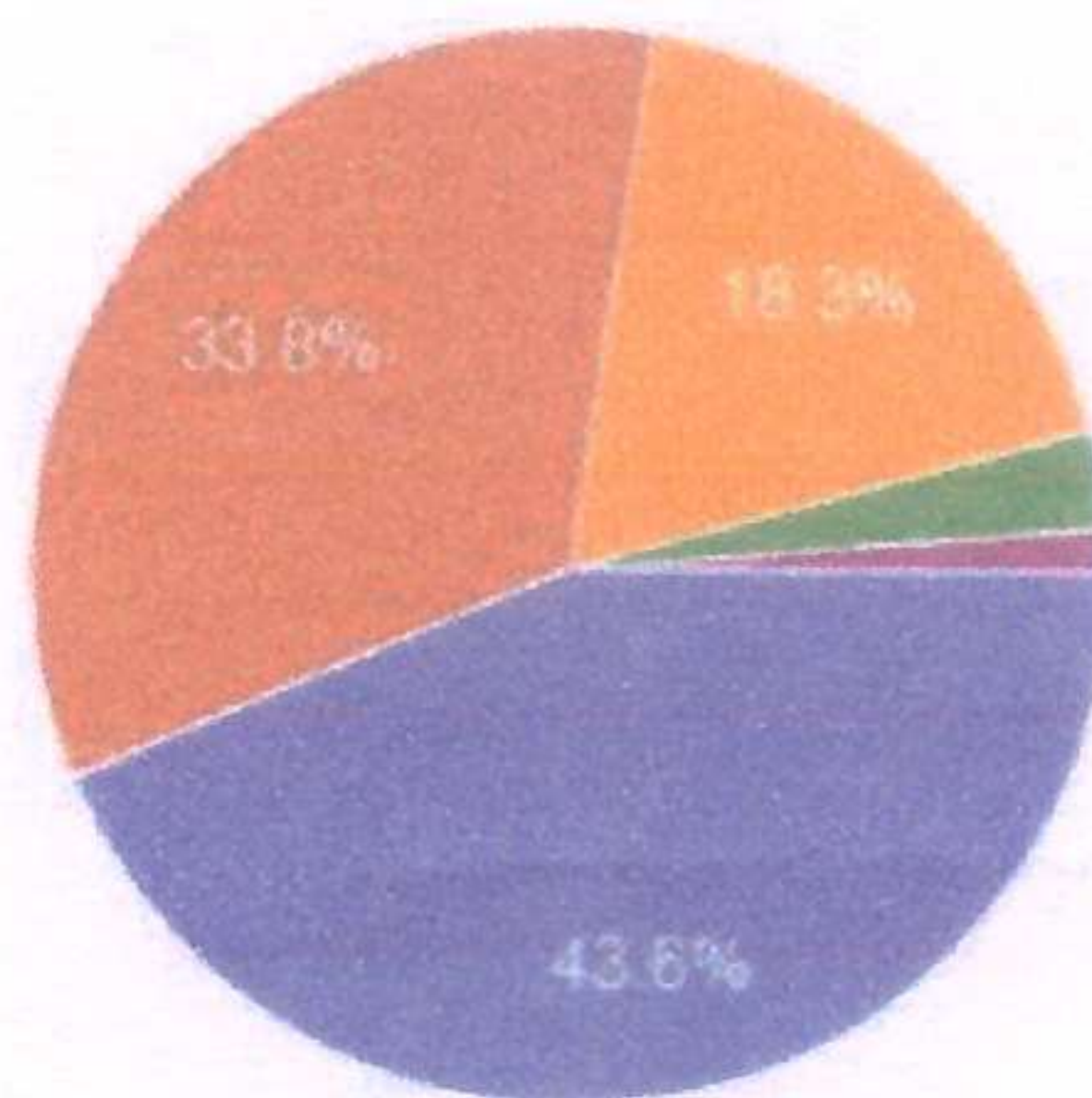

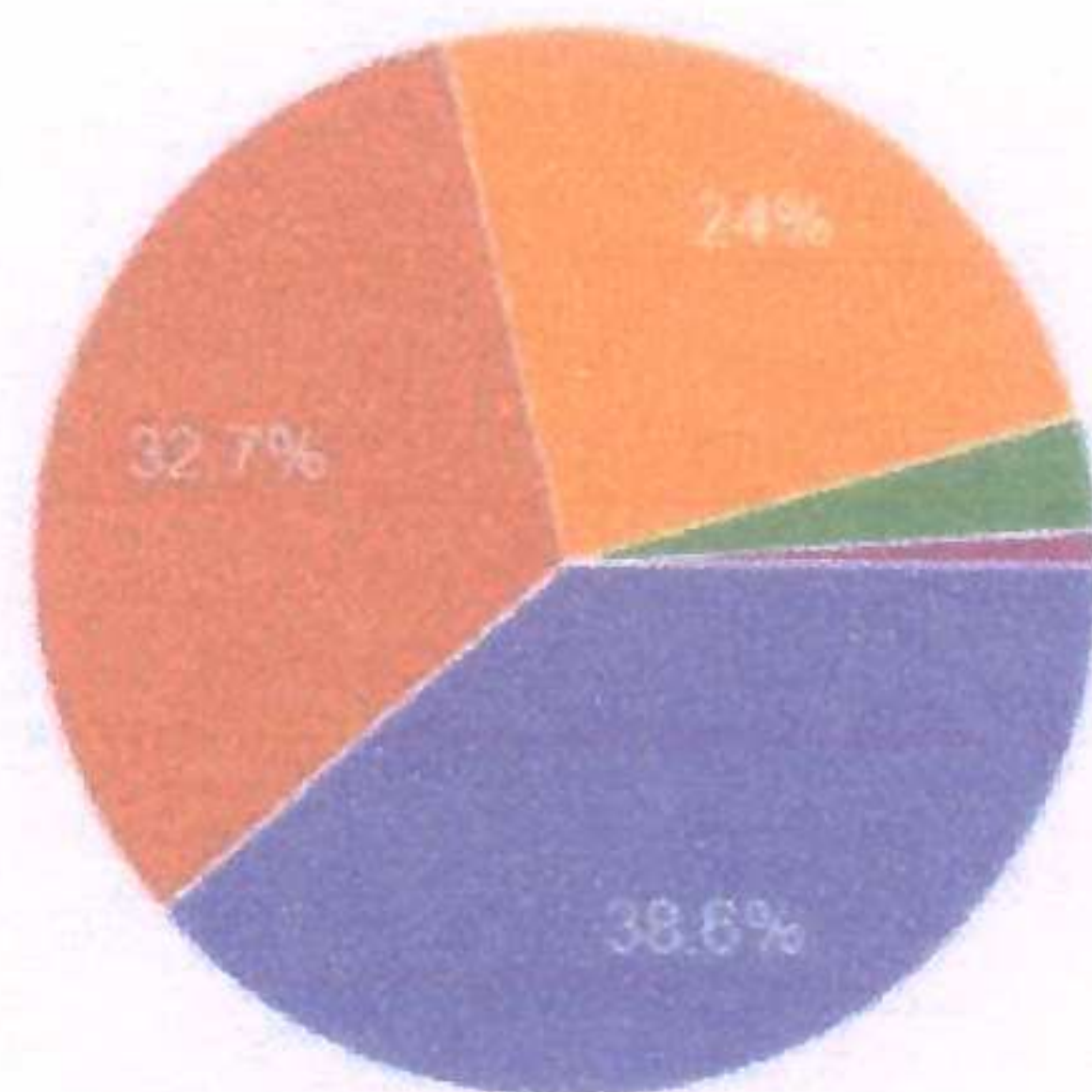

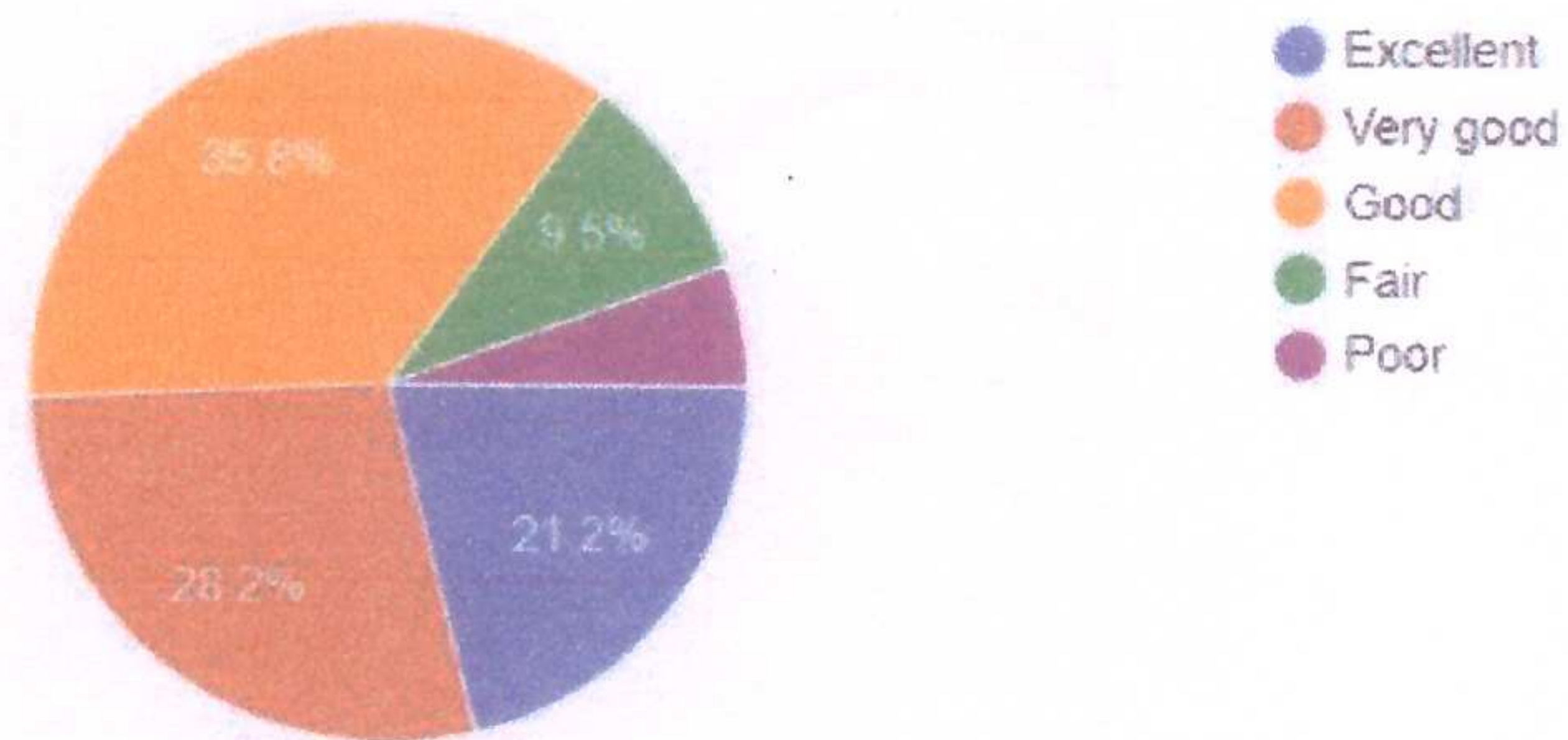

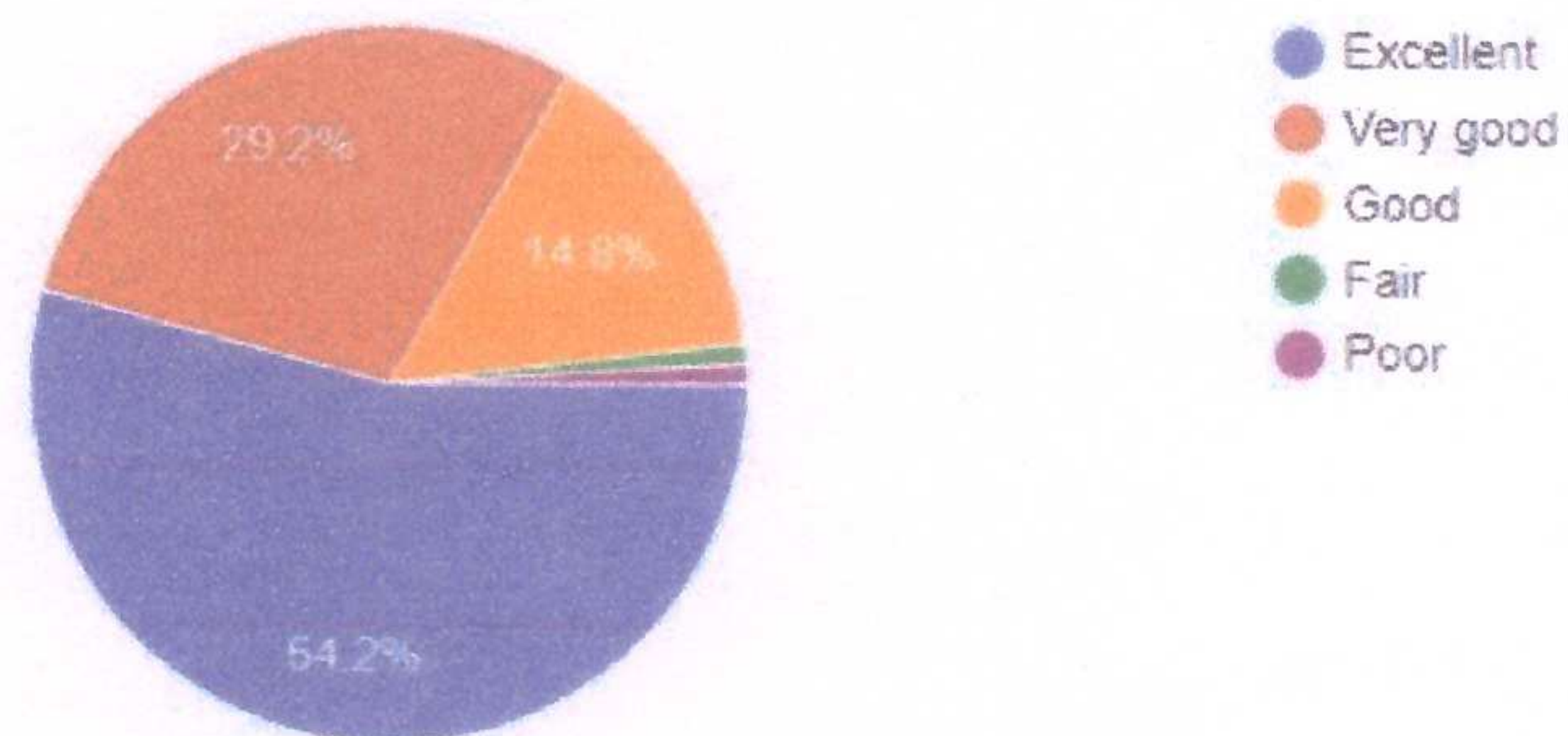
How do you rate the e-learning resources of the college such as computers, internet connectivity, smart class rooms etc.?

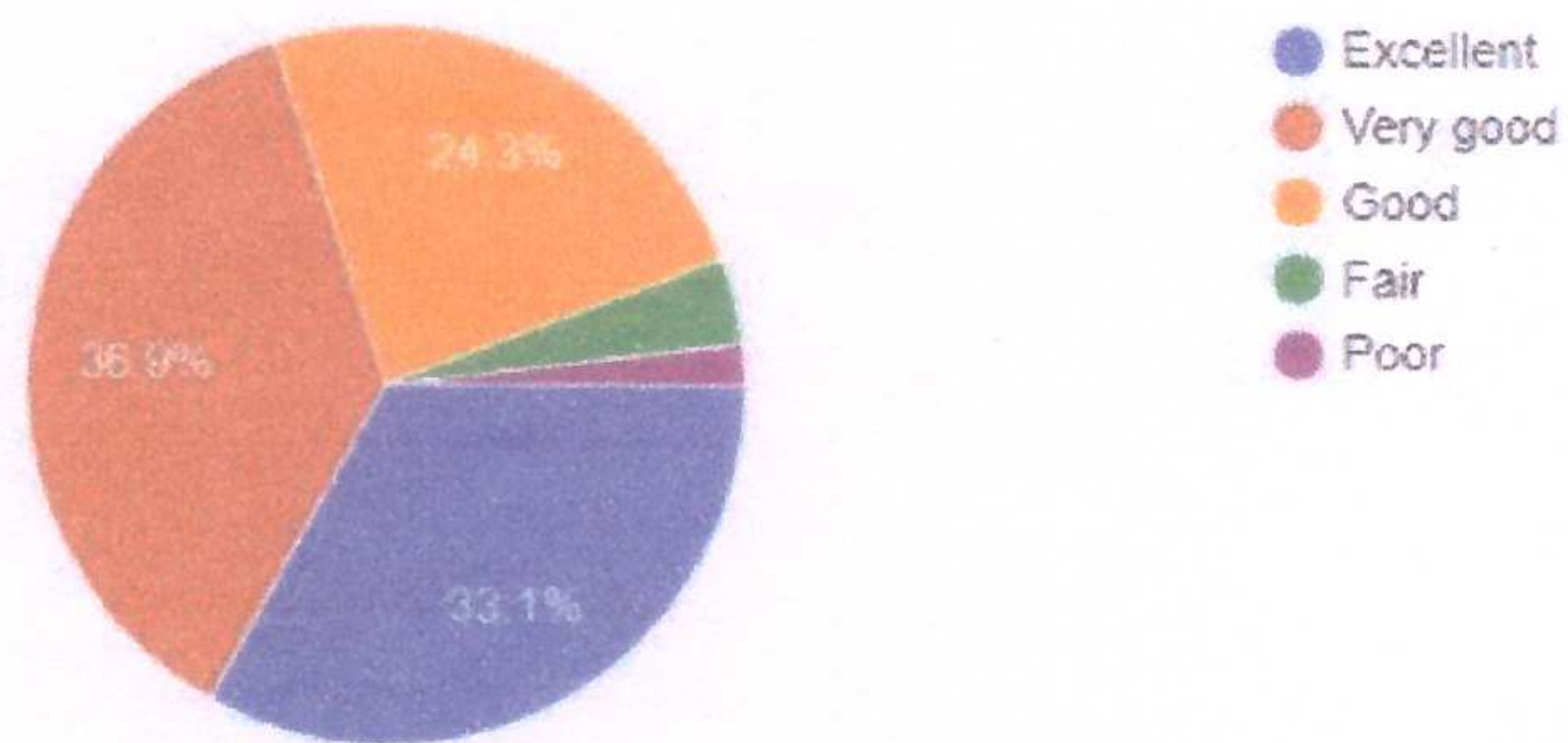

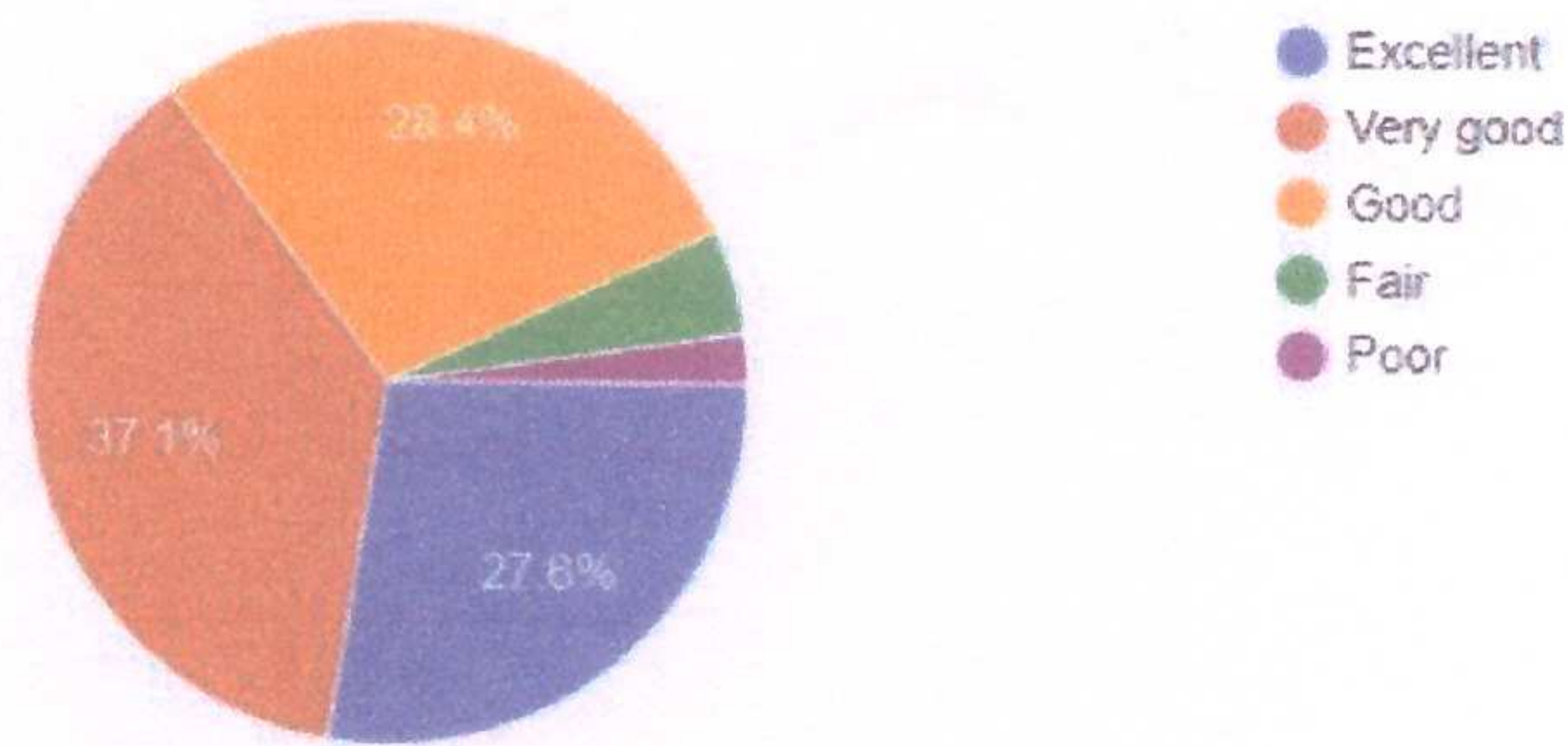

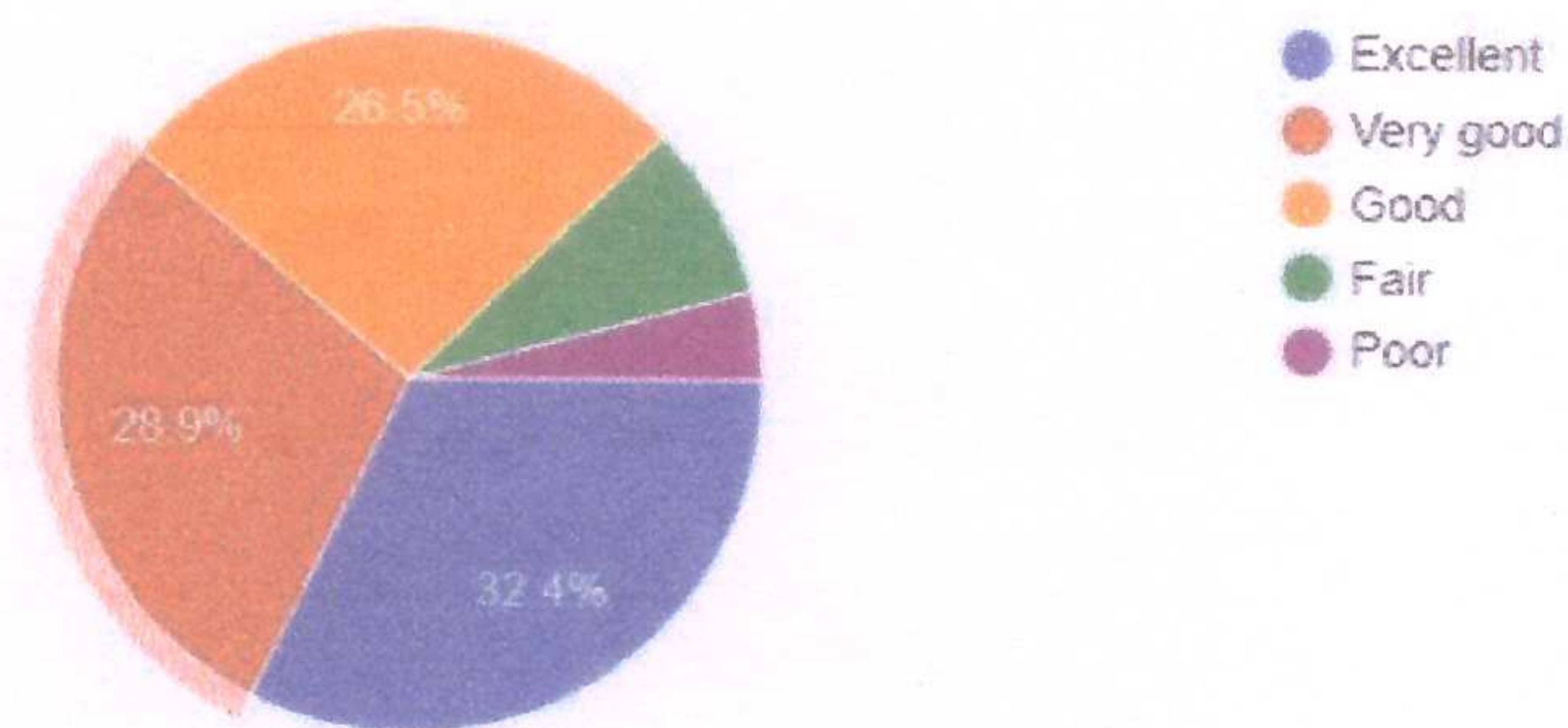
How do you rate the student progression and monitoring system of the college?

How do you rate the functioning of various clubs such as Nature club (Neithal), Film club, Literary club (Koodu), Music club etc.?

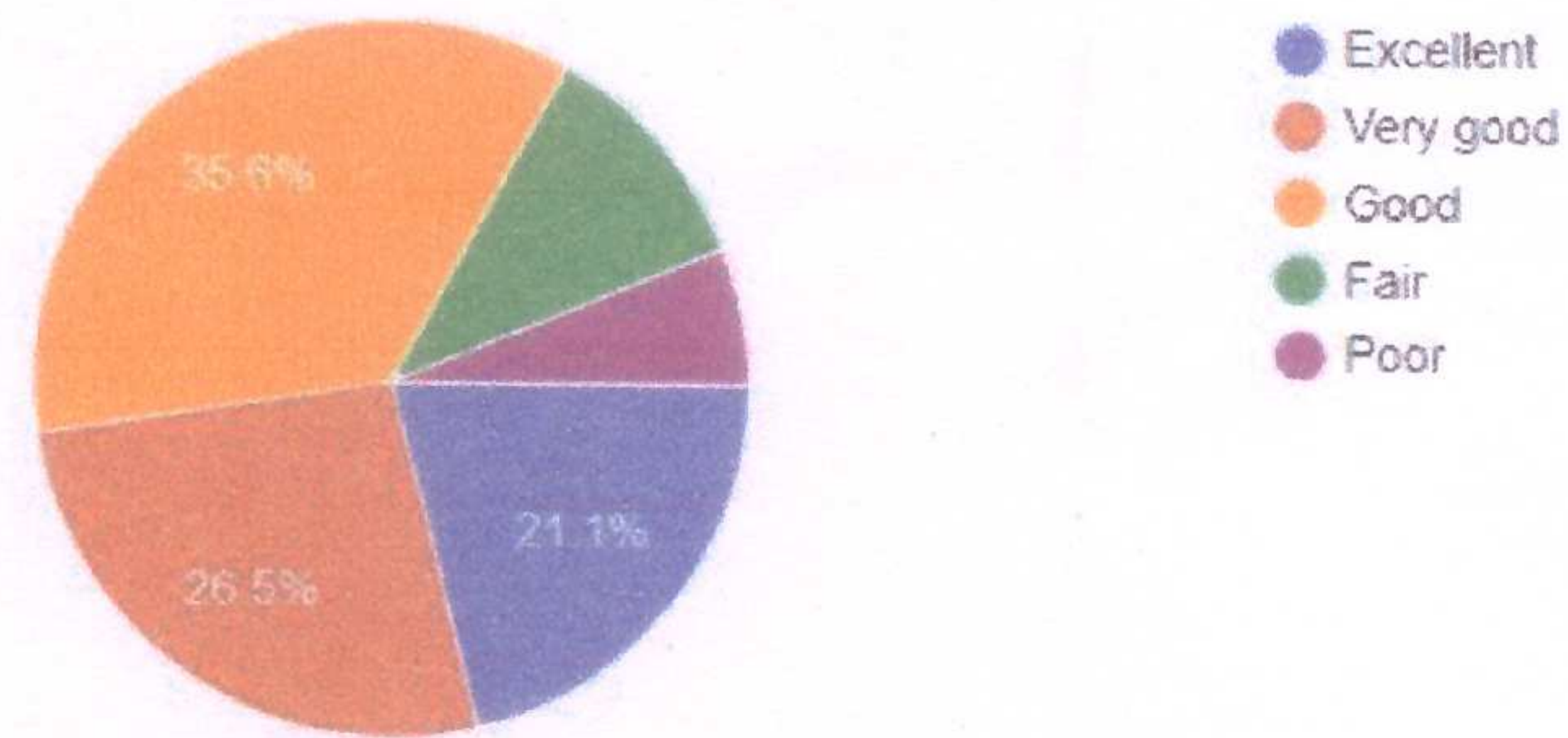

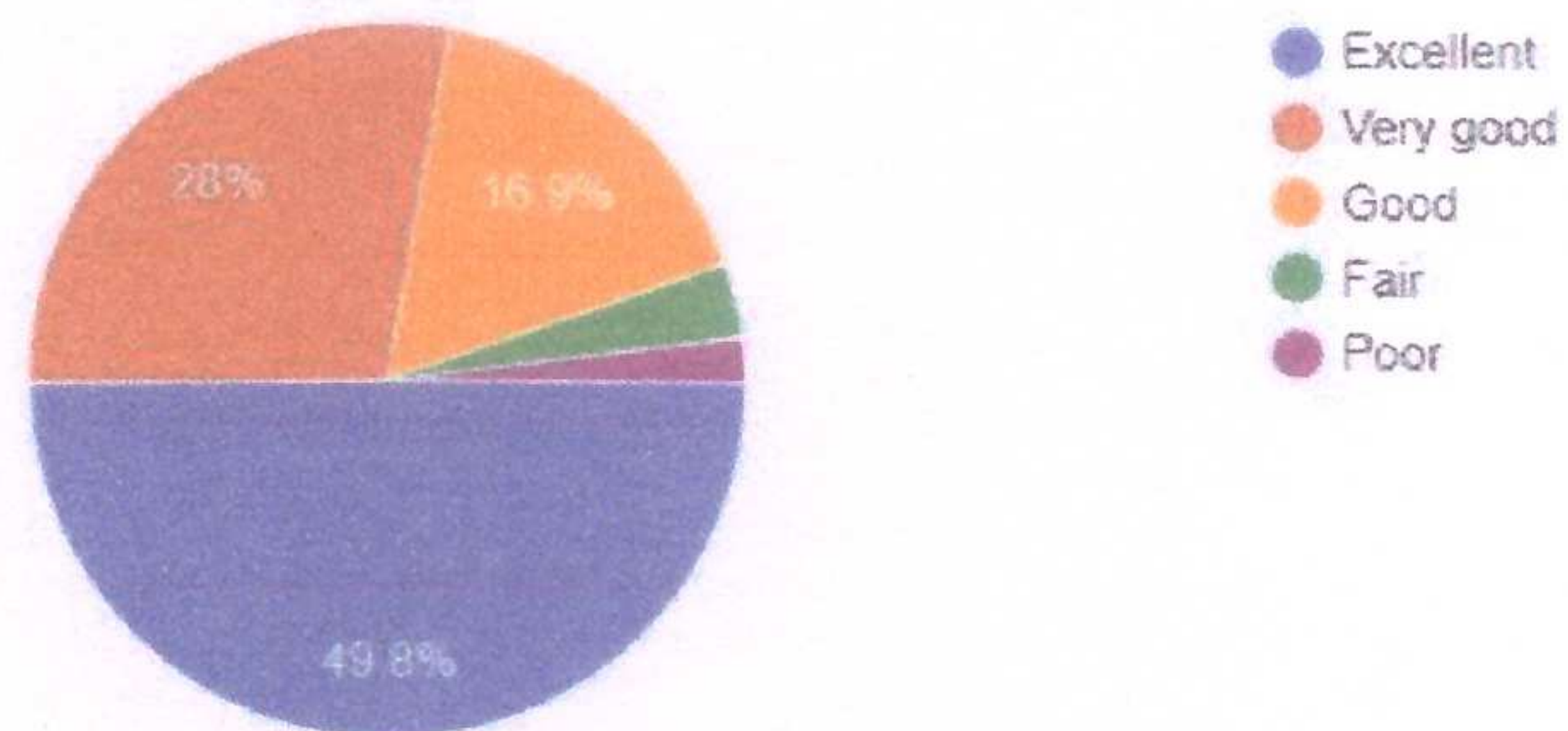
How do you rate the functioning of Parents Teacher Association(PTA) of the college?

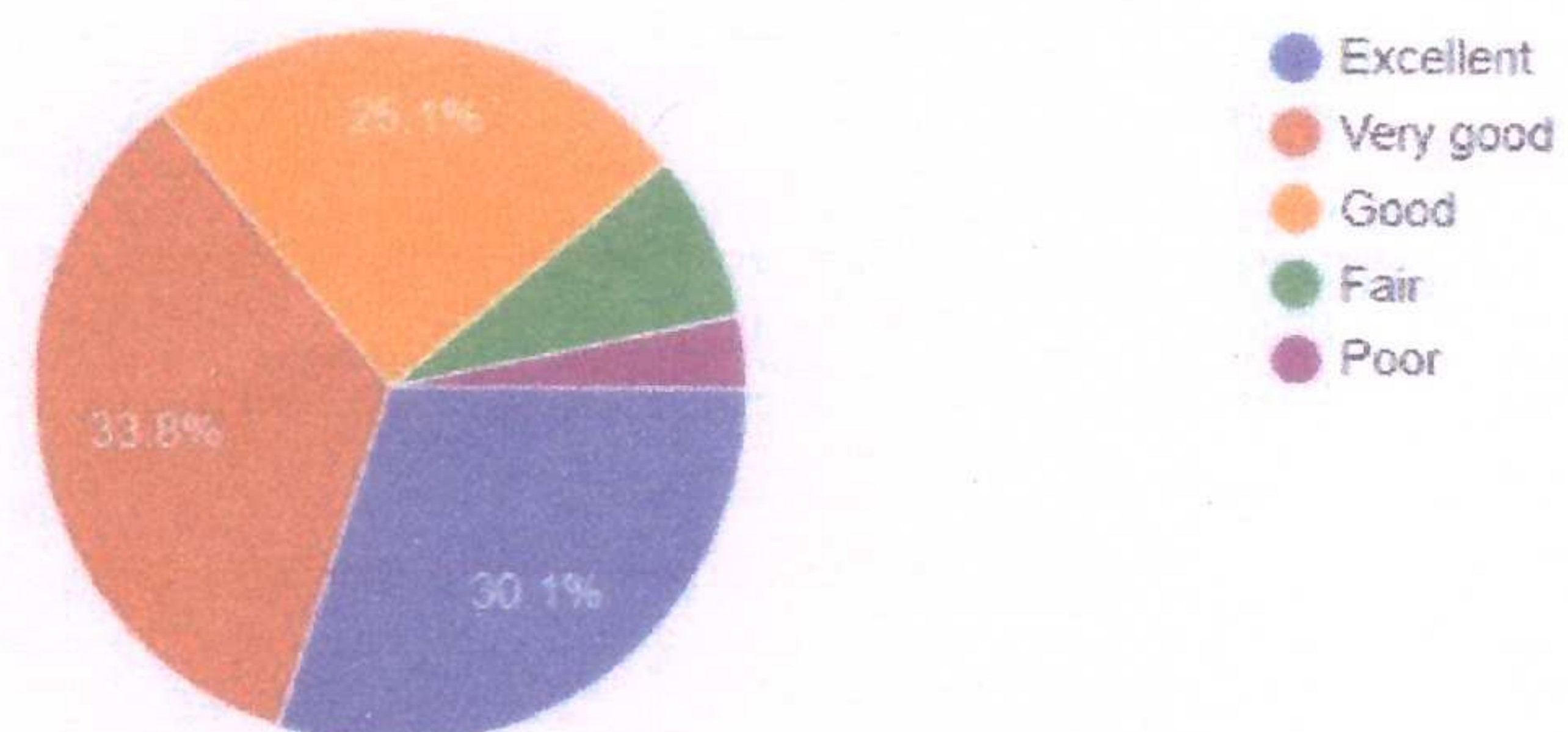

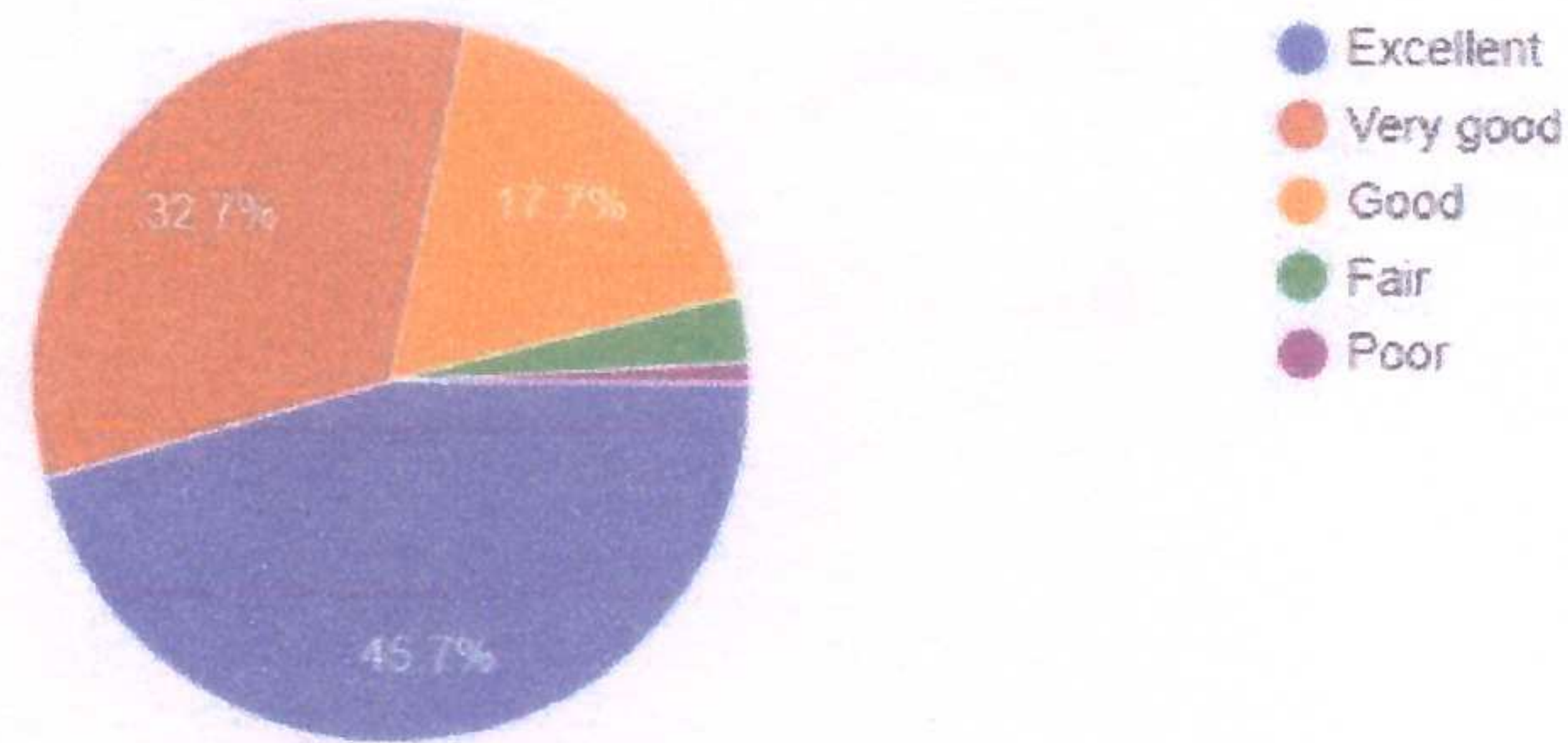

1. The curriculum and syllabus are well organized and easy to follow.

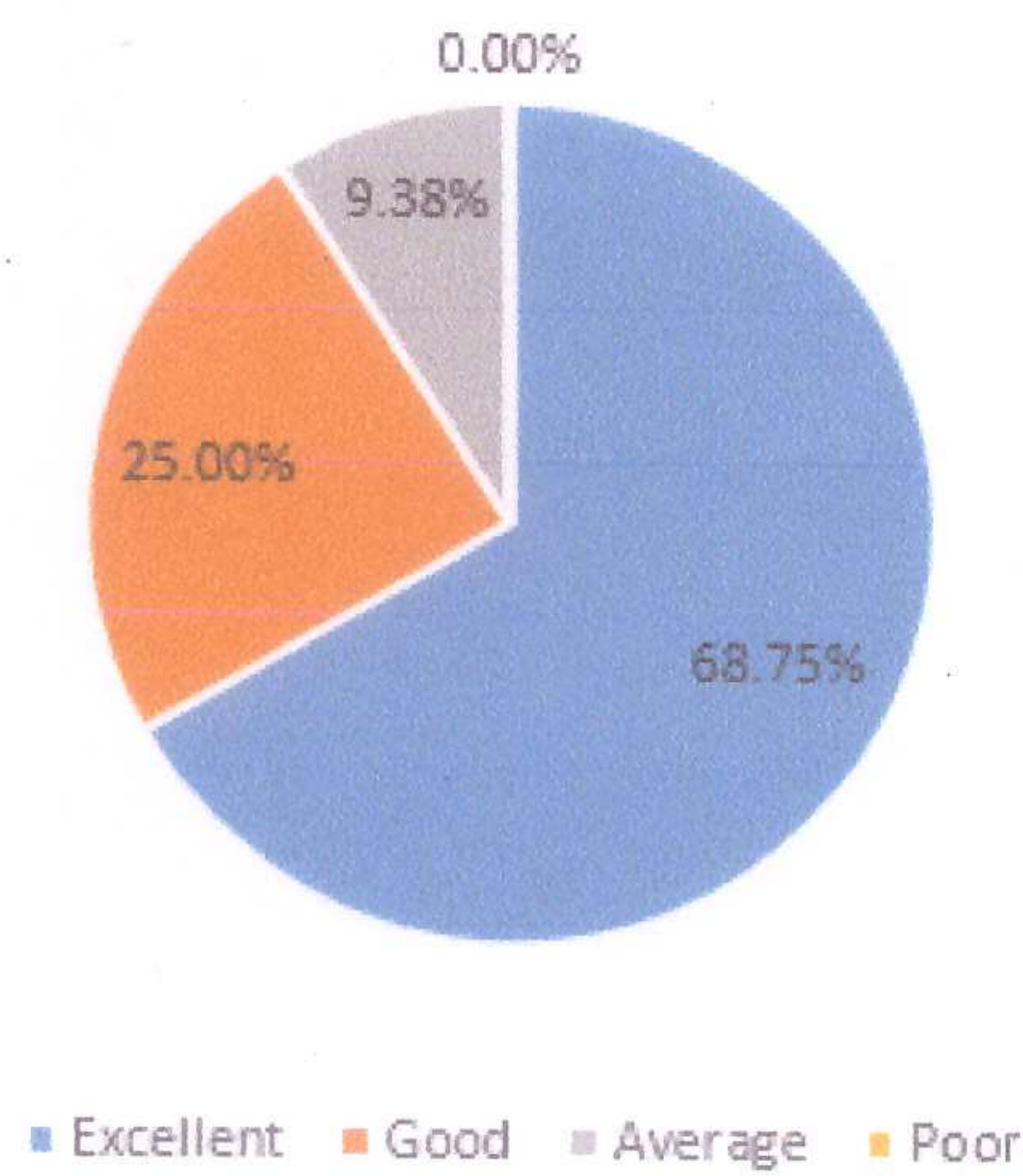

### 1. Support and contribution of the institution for your overall development

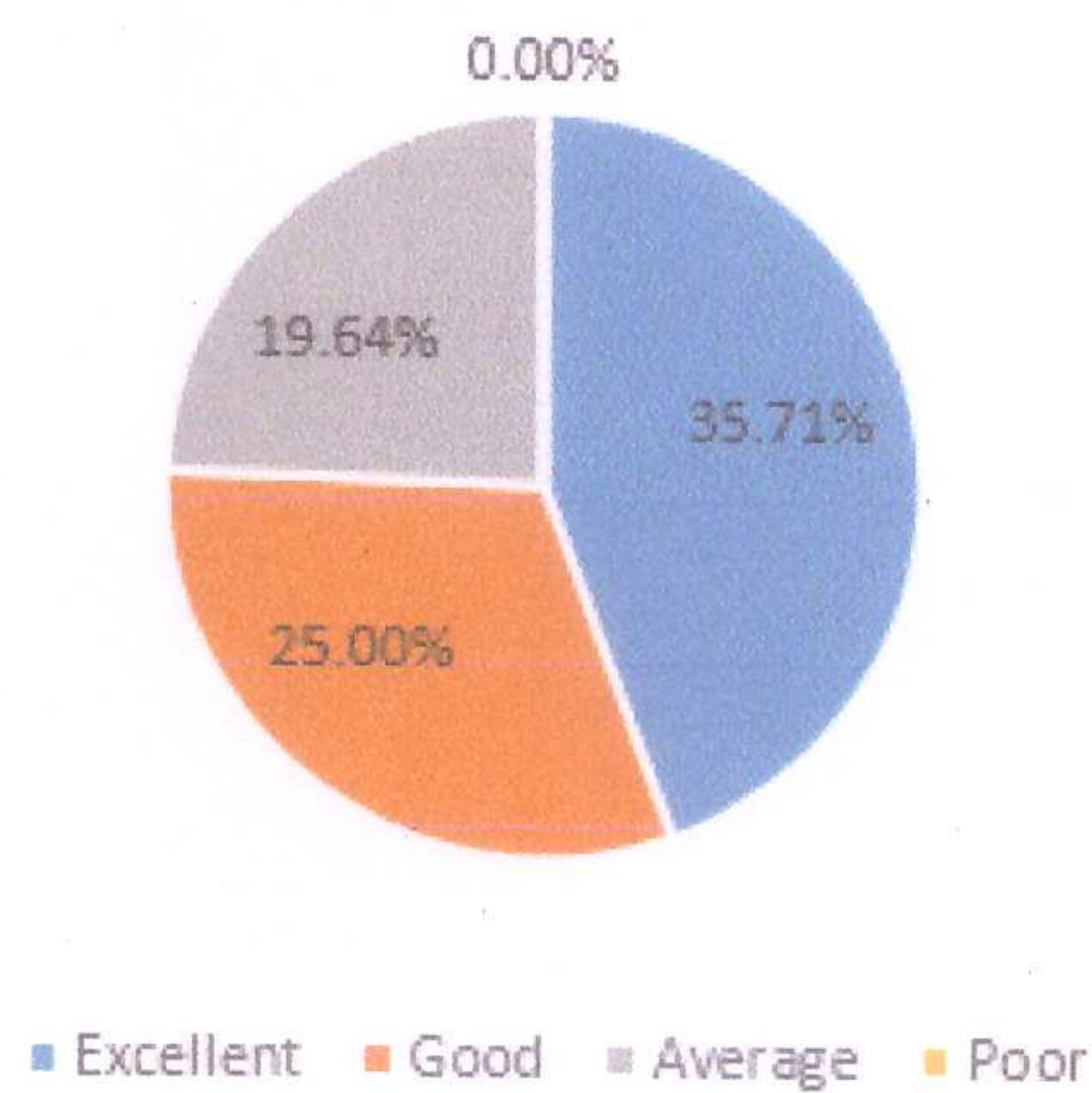
