The questionnaire was prepared and circulated as a google form among the students of the college. 530 students participated in the survey and the results were analyzed and summarised as follows.

1. Easiness of Curriculum and Syllabus to Understand:

Easiness of Curriculum and syllabus to understand



• Analysis: The majority of students (87.7%) find the curriculum and syllabus either good or excellent in terms of ease of understanding.

• Recommendations:

- Capitalize on the positive aspects by maintaining clarity and simplicity in course materials.
- Address the concerns of the small percentage that rated it as average, seeking specific feedback for improvement.

2. Logical Design and Depth of Courses in the Syllabus:

Logical design and depth of courses in the syllabus 530 responses



• Analysis: A significant proportion of students (85.7%) consider the logical design and depth of courses to be good or excellent.

• Recommendations:

- Continue emphasizing logical structuring of courses.
- Address any specific concerns raised by the minority who rated it as average.

3. Availability of Textbooks and Reference Materials:

Availability hard or soft copies of prescribed textbooks and reference books in the library/market ⁵³⁰ responses



• Analysis: A balanced response, with 82.6% of students rating the availability of materials as good or excellent.

• Recommendations:

- Identify and address specific challenges faced by the 17.4% who rated it as average or poor.
- Explore avenues for improving access to materials, both in the library and the market.
- 4. Applicability and Relevance of Course Content:

Applicability and relevance of contents of the courses to the real life situations 530 responses



- Analysis: A mixed response, with 80.2% rating the content as good or excellent.
- Recommendations:
 - \circ Investigate areas where real-life applications can be strengthened.
 - Address concerns raised by the 19.8% who rated it as average or poor.

5. Knowledge Advancement in the Syllabus:

The syllabus provides the advance knowledge of the subject 530 responses



- Analysis: The majority of students (88.1%) believe the syllabus provides advanced knowledge.
- Recommendations:
 - Maintain the focus on advanced concepts.
 - \circ $\;$ Explore ways to further enhance advanced content delivery.

6. Completion of Syllabus within Prescribed Time:

Completion of syllabus within the prescribed time. 530 responses



- Analysis: A positive response, with 81.3% of students satisfied with the timely completion of the syllabus.
- Recommendations:
 - Continue efforts to adhere to prescribed timelines.
 - \circ Investigate concerns raised by the 18.7% who rated it as average or poor.

7. Syllabus and Career Opportunities:

The syllabus provides sufficient and necessary knowledge with respect to future career opportunities.

- **Analysis:** A substantial number of students (86.4%) believe the syllabus provides sufficient knowledge for future career opportunities.
- Recommendations:
 - Align curriculum development with emerging career trends.
 - \circ Address concerns raised by the 13.6% who rated it as average or poor.

8. Satisfaction on Continuous Evaluation:

Satisfaction on the current system of continuous evaluation. 530 responses



- **Analysis:** A majority of students (78.3%) are satisfied with the current system of continuous evaluation.
- Recommendations:
 - \circ $\,$ Continue refining the continuous evaluation process.
 - \circ Address concerns raised by the 21.7% who rated it as average or poor.

9. Transparency in Continuous Evaluation Mechanism:

Transparency of the mechanism of continuous evaluation. 530 responses



- **Analysis:** A positive response, with 80.9% of students finding the continuous evaluation mechanism transparent.
- Recommendations:
 - Maintain and communicate transparency in the evaluation process.
 - \circ Address concerns raised by the 19.1% who rated it as average or poor.

10. Satisfaction with End Semester Examination:

Satisfaction on the current system of end semester examination. 530 responses



- Analysis: A balanced response, with 78.1% of students expressing satisfaction with the end semester examination system.
- Recommendations:
 - Continue efforts to improve the examination experience.
 - Address concerns raised by the 21.9% who rated it as average or poor.

- Recommendations:

- Recommendations:
 - Continue aligning the syllabus with socio-economic trends.
 - \circ Address concerns raised by the 13.2% who found it average.

- Analysis: A majority of students (92.1%) believe the syllabus provides sufficient depth for skill development.
