As a part of the college policy, feedback from Students, Teachers, and Alumni for the academic year 2023-2024 was collected and analyzed. The following concerns were noted:

From Students

- Course Syllabus Organization: A significant portion of students feel the syllabus could be better organized or clearer.
- Feedback Timeliness and Grading: Some students expressed concerns regarding the timeliness of feedback and fairness in grading.
- Assessment Design: While many students are satisfied with the assessments, a notable
 portion remains neutral or dissatisfied, suggesting room for improvement in assessment
 methods.

From Teachers

- Syllabus Updates and Flexibility: Some teachers expressed concerns about the regularity
 of syllabus updates and the level of academic flexibility.
- Assessment Clarity and Transparency: While most teachers agree on the clarity of assessment criteria, a small percentage noted areas for improvement.
- Teaching Methods: A few teachers suggested that teaching methods could be further refined to increase engagement and effectiveness.

From Alumni

- Career Counseling and Academic Advising: A significant portion of students expressed neutrality or dissatisfaction with the career counseling and advising services, suggesting that these services need to be more accessible or effective.
- Syllabus Relevance and Foundation for Future Pursuits: Though a majority agreed
 that the syllabus was relevant to their career goals and studies, a notable portion of students
 were neutral or disagreed, indicating potential gaps in aligning the syllabus with career
 preparation and further studies.
- Assessment Methods Transparency: Although most students felt assessments were fair
 and transparent, a notable portion expressed concerns, which calls for improving the
 communication and execution of assessment criteria.

The College Council discussed these concerns and decided to take the following steps to address the corresponding issues:

- Decided to communicate with the issues regarding the Organization, Relevance and Foundation for Future Pursuits, Updates and Flexibility of syllabus to the University of Calicut through Board of Studies Members of various disciplines.
- Decided to explore additional teaching methods to engage students more effectively, such as group discussions, case studies, or interactive learning tools and to incorporate more interactive and engaging teaching methods to cater to different learning styles and further increase student engagement.
- Decided to provide clearer guidelines and communication about assessment methods, criteria, and expectations to ensure greater transparency and fairness and to ensure that feedback on assignments and exams is provided in a timely manner to help students improve.
- Decided to improve the accessibility, visibility, and effectiveness of career counseling and academic advising services to better support students in their career and academic development.

Conclusion and Recommendations:

Strengths:

- Faculty Expertise: A high percentage of students (91.56%) believe faculty members are knowledgeable and experienced.
- Teaching Effectiveness: Most students find the teaching methods engaging and effective (83.73%).
- Timeliness of Feedback: 85.94% of students were satisfied with the timeliness of feedback on assignments and projects.
- Library and Resources: An impressive 86.74% of students found the library and other resources
 adequate and accessible.
- Recommendation to Others: A majority of 86.15% of students would recommend the college to
 others, indicating general satisfaction with the overall college experience.

Areas for Improvement:

- Career Counseling and Academic Advising: Around 27.11% of students expressed neutrality or dissatisfaction with the career counseling and advising services, suggesting that these services need to be more accessible or effective.
- Syllabus Relevance and Foundation for Future Pursuits: Though a majority agreed that the
 syllabus was relevant to their career goals and studies, 20-22% of students were neutral or disagreed,
 indicating potential gaps in aligning the syllabus with career preparation and further studies.
- Assessment Methods Transparency: Although most students felt assessments were fair and transparent, 22.29% expressed concerns, which calls for improving the communication and execution of assessment criteria.

Recommendations:

- Enhance Career Counseling and Advising: Improve the accessibility, visibility, and effectiveness
 of career counseling and academic advising services to better support students in their career and
 academic development.
- Align Syllabus with Career and Academic Goals: Reevaluate the syllabus to ensure it is better
 aligned with students' career goals and further academic pursuits. This might involve regular
 feedback from both students and industry professionals to ensure it remains relevant and robust.
- 3. Improve Assessment Clarity: Provide clearer guidelines and communication about assessment methods, criteria, and expectations to ensure greater transparency and fairness.
- 4. Foster an Even More Conducive Learning Environment: While most students find the classroom environment conducive to learning, it may be useful to address the concerns of the remaining students by exploring further improvements in classroom settings or teaching approaches.

The students expressed a positive outlook toward their academic journey, with notable satisfaction in areas such as faculty knowledge, teaching methods, and library resources. However, there are areas where improvement is needed, particularly in career counseling and academic advising services.
