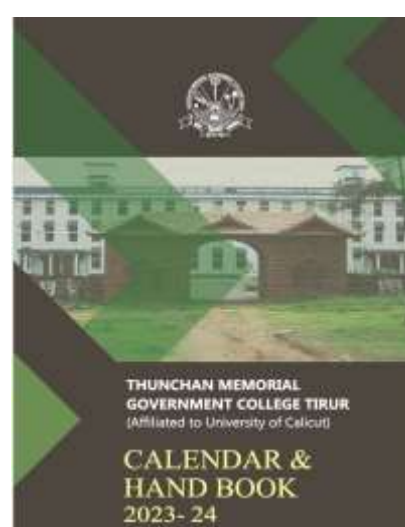

## Highlights of IQAC Initiatives

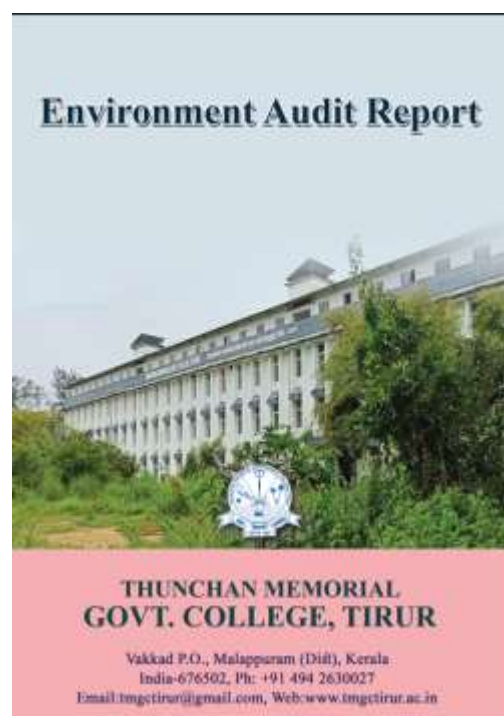
### Planning & Forecasting

Commerce Department: Hosted a workshop on Research Methodology.

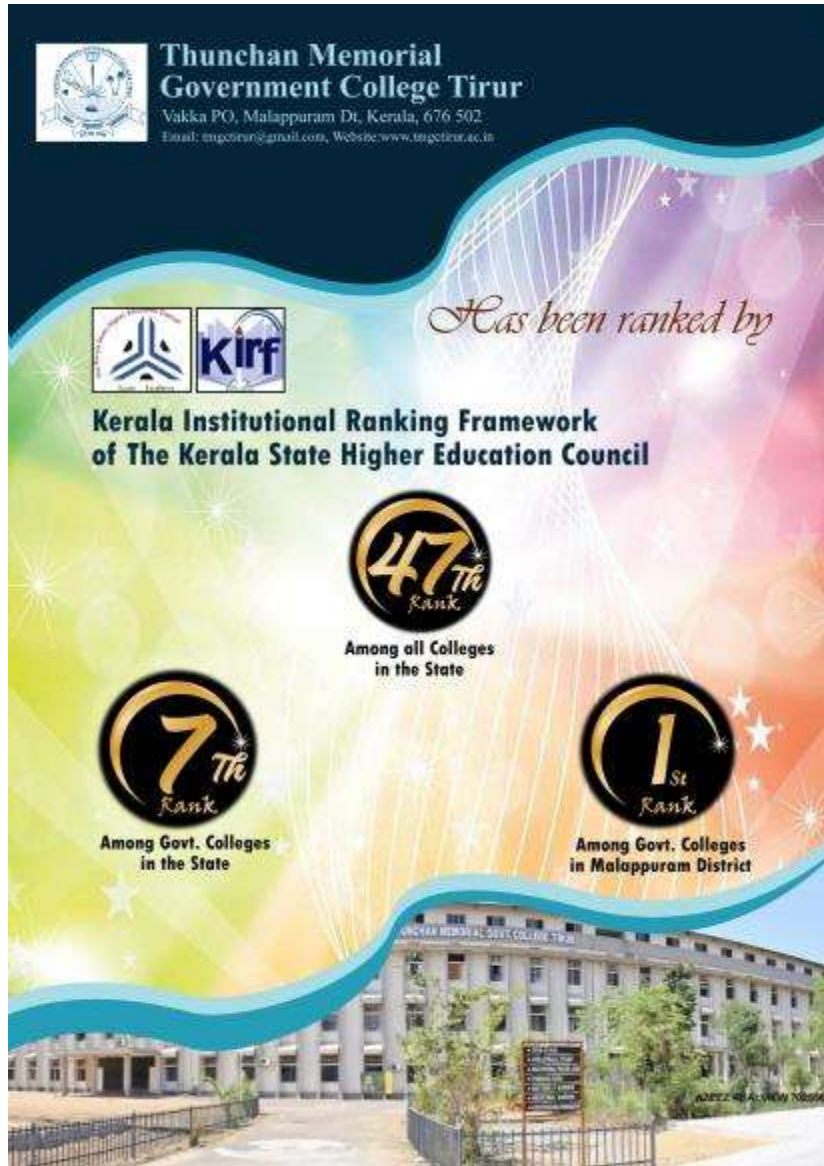
Arabic Department: Organized a session on Syllabus Framing as per FYUGP regulation.

Malayalam Department: Conducted a workshop on Research Methodology in association with Malayalam University and SNGS College, Pattambi.

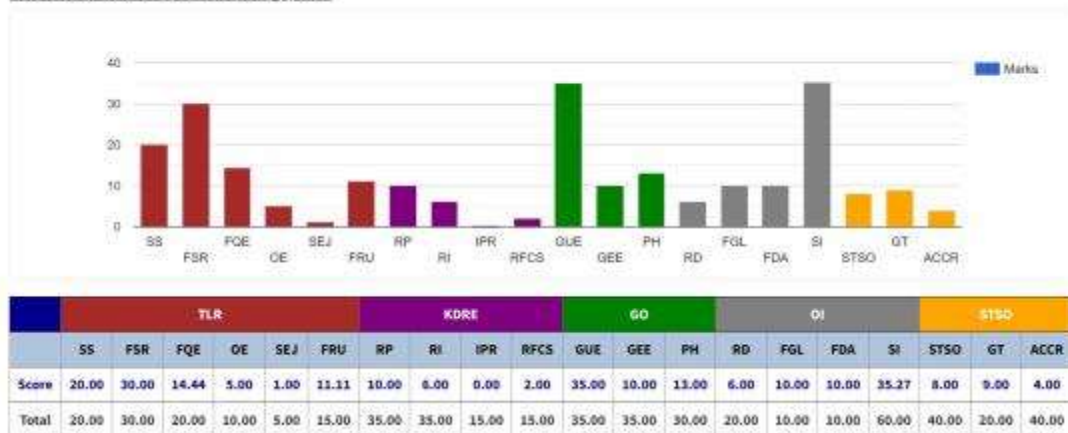
These initiatives encouraged knowledge sharing and strengthened the academic framework of the college.

### NAAC Peer Team Visit

The NAAC Peer Team visited the institution on 7–8 January 2024, and the initial accreditation result was released on 14 February 2024, assigning a B++ Grade with a CGPA of 2.99. Dissatisfied with the result, the college filed an appeal on 27 March 2024. However, the revised result released on 14 June 2024 reaffirmed the same grade and CGPA.
