



Action Taken Report on Action Plan (2023-24)

Introductory Note:

As per the Annual Action Plan 2023-24, the IQAC of the college is mainly focused on the completion of A&A process of 3rd Cycle Accreditation of the institution by the NAAC. The following actions are taken as per the stated annual action plan:

Academic Development:

- The college applied for new UG and PG programmes as per the decision of the college council.
- Total 19 Add On Courses were offered by the major departments of the college.
- Research Department of Arabic, Post Graduate Department of Malayalam and Post Graduate Mathematics conducted coaching classes for Competitive Examinations and UGC, CSIR NET, KTet Examinations.
- Research Department of Arabic conducted a Six Days Workshop on Revision of Syllabus as per New FYUGP Curriculum and the Post Graduate Department of Commerce conducted a Workshop on Research Methodology.
- Around 50 magazines (Printed and Digital) were subscribed in different subjects and languages
- Research Department of Arabic signed an MOU for collaboration with Ayur Green Ayurvedic Hospital Edappal to do the internship of UG students in Translation and Multilingual Interpretation.

Extracurricular Development:

- The Internal Complaint Committee was formed to face and solve the issues related to the complaints of students and teachers in the campus.
- NSS and NCC conducted more extension activities in and local surroundings of the campus.

- Continuing Education Cell was strengthened and it continued offering the existing vocational courses.
- The Earn While You Learn project was implemented in the college and more students were enrolled in the project to earn money by doing the assigned jobs in the campus.


Infrastructure Augmentation:

- An official G-Suite Account was created and provided to the students and teachers.
- The College Library was fully automated.
- More ICT devices for the use of students. 42 desktop computers, 15 laptops, LED Displays, LCD Projectors, PA Systems were augmented. Seminar Hall and Auditorium were equipped with modern ICT tools.
- The institution couldn't upgrade the Language Lab and LAN Lab due to technical issues.
- A proposal for construction of new academic block, seminar halls and other academic and co-academic facilities was prepared to submit to the NABARD as per the direction from the MLA of Kerala Assembly from Tirur Constituency. The proposed amount in 250 Lakh.
- The College bus was repaired and begun its service to transport the students from College to Tiuru Town.
- The capacity of the ladies hostel was enhanced by constructing one more floor above the existing building.
- Signboards of important facilities in the college were fixed.

IQAC Quality Initiatives:

- Internal Training sessions were conducted to the teaching and non-teaching staff on Quality Enhancement of the campus as part of the accreditation process.
- Completed the A&A processes of 3rd Cycle Accreditation by the NAAC and got B++ Grade with 2.99 CGPA Score.
- Participated in NIRF ranking process in 2023-24 but the institution is not included in the list of 200 colleges.
